5. Draft Government Regulation on technical requirements and other specifications for certain arms, ammunition and firing ranges and for securing arms and ammunition

6. technical requirements and specifications for certain arms, ammunition and firing ranges

8. The Government Decree provides:

- technical requirements for the production design of arms of category PO or NO to make it impossible to convert them into arms subject to registration;
- technical and organisational definition of firing ranges, the operation of which can be permitted without submitting a statement from the regional sanitary station;
- technical requirements for steel boxes and cabinets, special equipment, safes and vaults, rooms and separate structures and their locking;
- technical requirements for the method required to secure arms or ammunition during short-term storage in a vehicle;
- mandatory elements of a project of an alternative method of securing arms or ammunition;
- means of marking arms with identification data and other means of individual identification of arms of special historical value;
- the specimen of the deactivation control mark, deactivation verification marks of the Czech Proof House for Arms and Ammunition and the Ministry of Defence, and the deactivated arms certificate;
- technical requirements for the irreversible conversion of arms in the event of deactivation of arms not covered by Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/2403 of 15 December 2015, establishing common guidelines on deactivation standards and techniques to ensure that deactivated firearms are rendered irreversibly inoperable;
- technical requirements for the irreversible conversion of arms in the case of creation of arms cross-sections;
- technical requirements for the disassembly, deactivation, making cross-sections and destruction of ammunition;
- technical requirements for the handling of active components of ammunition;
- the limit quantity of active components of ammunition pursuant to § 96(3) and § 111(1)(b) of the Arms and Ammunition Act; and
- organisational and technical conditions for securing arms or ammunition during transport.

The draft Government Regulation refers to the following EU legislation:

Directive (EU) 2021/555 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 March 2021 on control of the acquisition and possession of weapons (codified version)

- Commission Implementing Directive (EU) 2019/68 of 16 January 2019 laying down technical specifications for the marking of firearms and their essential parts pursuant to Council Directive 91/477/EEC on control of the acquisition and possession of weapons
- Commission Implementing Directive (EU) 2019/69 of 16 January 2019 laying down technical specifications for alarm and signal weapons under Council Directive 91/477/EEC on control of the acquisition and possession of weapons.
- Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2015/2403 of 15 December 2015 establishing common guidelines on deactivation standards and techniques for ensuring that deactivated firearms are rendered

irreversibly inoperable.

The draft Government Decree refers to the following international regulations:

- Treaty on Conventional Armed Forces in Europe, promulgated under No 94/2003
- European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Road (ADR), promulgated under No 64/1987, as amended
- Convention concerning International Carriage by Rail (COTIF), promulgated under No 8/1985, as amended
- European Agreement concerning the International Carriage of Dangerous Goods by Inland Waterways (ADN), promulgated under No 102/2011, as amended

The draft Government Regulation refers to the following national technical standards:

Security storage units – Requirements, classification and methods of testing resistance against burglary –
Part 1: Cabinet safes, ATM safes, safe doors and vaults
- ČSN EN 1300 (catalogue number 519278)
Security storage units - Classification of high-security locks based on their resistance to unauthorised opening
- ČSN EN 1627 (catalogue number 514152)
Doors, windows, light curtain walls, grilles and shutters - Burglar resistance - Requirements and classification

9. This Government Regulation is among the legislation prepared for the implementation of Act No 90/2024 on arms and ammunition, which will come into effect on 1 January 2026.

As at this date, all existing regulations implementing the current Arms Act will be repealed. These include those regulating technical requirements for the production, conversion, and security of arms and ammunition and for firing ranges, hence it is necessary to replace these rules.

The basic act, Act No 90/2024 on arms and ammunition was previously notified as a draft act for notification 2022/605/CZ.
