Regulations of the Swedish Agency for Marine and Water Management amending the Regulations of the Swedish National Board of Fisheries (FIFS 2004:25) on access to resources and fisheries control

By virtue of Chapter 5 Section 7 of the Ordinance (1994:1716) on fisheries, aquaculture and the fishing industry, the Swedish Agency for Marine and Water Management hereby lays down, with respect to Regulations of the Swedish National Board of Fisheries (FIFS 2004:25) on access to resources and fisheries control, that a new section, namely Chapter 12 Section 6a, shall be introduced.¹

Chapter 12 Weighing of catches

Section 6a A fully or semi-automatic sampling device shall be used for the sampling unsorted catches exceeding 10 tonnes in accordance with Section 6.

A sampling tube, or gutter, shall be fitted to the pipe, or conveyor belt, before grading. When the tube, or gutter, is opened, a predetermined catch amount shall automatically be removed from the stream and then collected in a vessel.

These Regulations shall enter into force on Enter date.
