8. THIS IS AN UPDATE TO THE EXISTING TECHNICAL GUIDELINE IN LIGHT OF NEW TECHNICAL STANDARDS AND TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCES.

9. THIS TECHNICAL GUIDELINE SETS OUT RECOMMENDED MEASURES TO REDUCE THE RISK OF FATALITIES CAUSED BY ELECTRIC SHOCK IN BUILDINGS AND TO MINIMISE DAMAGE TO THE BUILDING.

9a. THE TECHNICAL GUIDELINE SETS OUT THE REQUIREMENTS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 25 OF THE CONSTRUCTION ACT (ESSENTIAL AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS), WHICH SUBSTANTIVELY COVERS PART OF THE BASIC REQUIREMENTS SET OUT IN THE EU REGULATION ON THE MARKETING OF CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS. THE FIRST NATIONAL REGULATIONS IN THIS FIELD DATE BACK TO THE 1970S, WHICH HIGHLIGHTS THE NEED FOR REGULATION OF THE DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION OF SAFE BUILDINGS. THE TECHNICAL GUIDELINE SPECIFIES TECHNICAL MEASURES FOR PROTECTION AGAINST ELECTRIC SHOCK, WHICH FORM A PART OF THE REGULATIONS ON LOW-VOLTAGE ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS IN BUILDINGS AND THE PROTECTION OF BUILDINGS AGAINST LIGHTNING.

9b. THE CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS IS NOT A PART OF THE HARMONISED EU LEGAL FRAMEWORK; THE TECHNICAL GUIDELINE DOES NOT REFER TO ANY EUROPEAN IN THE FIELD OF LOW-VOLTAGE ELECTRICAL INSTALLATIONS AND RELATED CONSTRUCTION PRODUCTS, THEREFORE IT DOES NOT CONSTITUTE A RESTRICTION ON THE INTERNAL MARKET.

9c. NORMATIVE REGULATION OF THE AREA IS NECESSARY TO REDUCE THE RISK OF DEATH OR SERIOUS INJURY TO BUILDING USERS.
