5. Ministerial Decree laying down 'Production specifications for "Pork Meat from Sustainable Farming" within the framework of the National Animal Husbandry Quality Scheme (SQNZ) – Ministerial Decree No 646632 of 16 December 2022'

6. The product specification 'Sustainable farmed pork meat' is applicable to the rearing activity for the

production of pork meat and its products may be referred to as 'Sustainable farmed pork meat'.

8. The product specification for 'Sustainable pork meat' shall apply without prejudice to the provisions deriving from higher-grade sources, in particular with regard to European Union and national legislation on the safety of the food chain, animal health and welfare and the placing of products on the market.

The specification 'Pork meat from sustainable farming' is applicable to the farming activity for the production of pork meat and proposes a pathway to sustainability for farms.

The aim with regard to "sustainability" is to improve and monitor the conditions of animal welfare and the environment and to promote the launch of a circular economy, leading to the reuse of edible food materials and waste, safeguarding the social and economic conditions of farmers.

Pork produced in accordance with the specification may be labelled "from sustainable farming".

The draft decree consists of 14 chapters.

9. The measure protects the interests of pig farmers who, in compliance with the provisions deriving from higher-level sources (EU and national legislation on the safety of the food chain, animal health and welfare and the placing of products on the market), seek to enhance the value of their products with a view to improving rearing standards and sustainability, as provided for in Articles 12 and 46 of Regulation EU 2022/126.

9a. Through voluntary adherence to the product specifications made up of defined and certified rules, in any case with priority being given to the provisions deriving from higher-level sources (European Union legislation and national legislation on the safety of the food chain, animal health and welfare and the placing of products on the market).

The specifications, adherence to which is voluntary, sets out rules (which ensure a higher quality product) that are clearly defined, identifiable and certifiable by accredited inspection bodies supervised by the competent authority.

9b. Compliance with the specifications is voluntary; it does not entail any restrictions on the internal market nor does it have any impact on cross-border trade, which therefore remains unaffected.

9c. Adherence to the product specifications is voluntary and does not impose any restrictions on rights and freedoms.
