

**LAW AMENDING ARTICLE 6¹
OF THE LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA
ON FOOD No VIII-1608**

Article 1. Amendment to Article 6¹

Article 6¹ shall be amended to be worded as follows:

“Article 6¹. Restrictions on the sale of certain food products

It shall be prohibited to sell, purchase or otherwise transfer energy drinks and non-alcoholic beverages whose names include the designation of a group, sub-group and/or category of alcoholic beverages, as defined by an authority authorised by the Government of the Republic of Lithuania in accordance with the Law on Alcohol Control of the Republic of Lithuania or by directly applicable European Union legislation, to persons under 18 years of age. Sellers of the energy drinks and non-alcoholic beverages referred to in this Article shall have the right and, where there is doubt that a person is under 18 years of age, the obligation to require the person purchasing the energy drinks and non-alcoholic beverages referred to in this Article to present a document confirming the person’s identity. If such a person does not present a document confirming their identity, sellers of the energy drinks and non-alcoholic beverages referred to in this Article must refuse to sell these energy drinks and non-alcoholic beverages to them.”

Article 2. Entry into force of the Act

This Law comes into force on 1 November 2026.
