Decree implementing Article L.1115-1 of the Transport Code

NOR:

Groups concerned: *Holders and users of data enabling the provision of multimodal travel information services and in particular transport authorities including mobility authorities, local and regional authorities and their groupings.*

Subject: *The text specifies the conditions for application of Article L. 1115-1 of the Transport Code. It sets out the categories of data that are provided through the National Access Point (NAP). It shall indicate the address at which information relating to data characteristics and formats may be accessed. It specifies that responsibility for the provision of such data lies with the data holders, even where they entrust that responsibility to third parties.*

Entry into force: *The text shall enter into force on the day following its publication.*

Application: *This decree is adopted pursuant to Article L.1115-1 of the Transport Code.*

Having regard to Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/490 of 29 November 2023 amending Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926 supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the provision of EU-wide multimodal travel information services;

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data;

Having regard to the Transport Code, in particular Articles L.1115-1, L.1231-1, L.1231-3, L.1241-1 and L.1811-2 thereof;

Having regard to the Code on Relations between the Public and the Administration, in particular Article L231-1 thereof;

Having regard to Law No. 2025-391 of 30 April 2025 containing various provisions for alignment with European Union law in the fields of the economy, finance, the environment, energy, transport, health and the movement of persons, and in particular Article 29 thereof;

Having regard to Decree No. 2020-1753 of 28 December 2020 on certain conditions for the provision of digital data intended to facilitate travel;

Having regard to the opinion of the National Commission on Information Technology and Liberties of

Having regard to the opinion of the Transport Regulatory Authority of XXX

Hereby decrees:

Article 1

In Section I of Chapter V of Title I of Book I of Part One of the regulatory part of the Transport Code, Articles D.1115-2 to D.1115-4 are inserted after Article D.1115-1 and shall read as follows:

'Article D. 1115-2 – The data relating to multimodal travel and traffic that are updated and made accessible and reusable through the National Access Point, as defined in Article 2 of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926 of 31 May 2017 supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU, are as follows:

- static data
- historical data
- observed data
- dynamic data

'Art. D. 1115-3 - The format and characteristics of the data listed in Article D.1115-2 are specified at the following address:

'Article D. 1115-4 – The holders and users of data referred to in paragraph 1 of Article L.1115-1, transport authorities, local authorities and their groupings, and providers of vehicle-sharing, bicycle-sharing and personal mobility device-sharing services are responsible for supplying data via the National Access Point, including where they entrust that responsibility to a third party.

Article 2

The Minister of Transport shall be responsible for the implementation of this Decree, which shall be published in the Official Journal.
