

Pursuant to Article 10(1)(1) and Article 46(1)(1) and (2) of the Motor Vehicles Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, Nos 75/17 and 92/20 – ZPrCP-E), in conjunction with Article 27a(3) of the Road Traffic Rules Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, Nos 156/21 – official consolidated text, 161/21 – corr., 22/25 and 86/25 – Decision of the Constitutional Court), the Minister for Infrastructure issues the following

R U L E S

amending and supplementing the Rules on parts and equipment of vehicles

Article 1 (Information procedure and clause)

These Rules have been issued taking into account the information procedure in accordance with Directive (EU) 2015/1535 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 September 2015 laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical regulations and of rules on Information Society services (OJ L 241, 17. 9. 2015, p. 1).

The provisions of these Rules shall not apply to products that are legally produced or marketed in other Member States of the European Union and Turkey or produced in the countries of the European Free Trade Association (EFTA), which are also signatories to the Agreement on the European Economic Area, in accordance with national legislation ensuring an equivalent level of protection of the public interest as determined by the legislation of the Republic of Slovenia.

These Rules shall be implemented in accordance with Regulation (EU) 2019/515 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 March 2019 on the mutual recognition of goods lawfully marketed in another Member State and repealing Regulation (EC) No 764/2008 (OJ L 91, 29. 3. 2019, p. 1).

Article 2

In Article 4(1) of the Rules on parts and equipment of vehicles (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, Nos 16/22 and 58/22), a new item 2 is added after item 1, reading:
“2. ‘automated vehicle’ means a motor vehicle as defined by the law governing road traffic rules;”.

The current items 2 to 19 shall become items 3 to 20.

Article 3

After Article 66, a new Chapter V.a and a new Article 66a are added, which read as follows:

“V.a AUTOMATED VEHICLES

Article 66a

(Marking plate for automated vehicles)

(1) The marking plate for automated vehicles (hereinafter called the “CAV” plate) shall be of square shape and of red colour (colour shade RAL 3020 or colour shade equivalent to RAL 3020 in other colour standards) and shall bear the letters “CAV” in white (colour shade RAL 9016 or colour shade equivalent to RAL 9016 in other colour standards). The shape, graphic design and minimum dimensions of the “CAV” plate, including the size and thickness of the letters on the plate, are set out in Annex 7, which is an integral part of these Rules. “CAV” plates in larger dimensions may also be used, provided that their dimensions shall be proportionate to those specified in Annex 7 of these Rules. The corners of the “CAV” plate may be rounded.

(2) The “CAV” plate is located on the left half of the rear of the automated vehicle so that it fully forms a right angle with the horizontal axis of the road and is easily visible to other road users.”.

Article 4

After Annex 6, a new Annex 7 is added, which forms an integral part of these Rules as the Annex.

FINAL PROVISION

Article 5

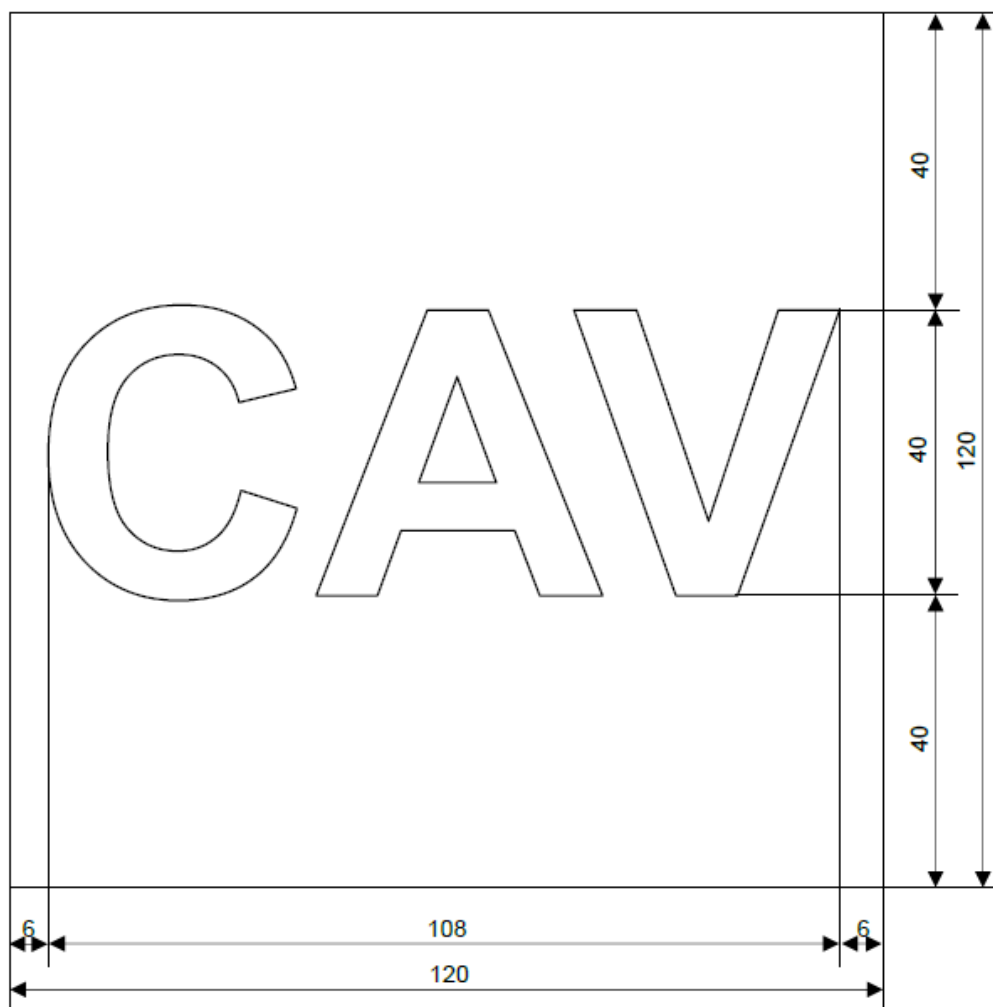
(Entry into force)
