5. Ministry of the Environment Decree on the type approval of PE pipes intended for water and sewerage

systems in buildings

6. Polyethylene pipes (PE pipes) intended for the conveyance of pressurised drinking water and sewage in buildings and properties.

This Decree concerns the requirements for the type approval of polyethylene pipes (hereinafter PE pipes) in water and sewerage systems intended for the conveyance of pressurised drinking water and sewage in buildings and properties. The current Regulation (1/20) repeals the provisions concerning eligibility for the management of drinking water. In other respects, no changes would be made to the section.

9. The EU's new Drinking Water Directive (EU) 2020/2184 and its hygiene requirements have been implemented through legislation issued by the Ministry of Social Affairs and Health. Regulations in the Ministry of the Environment's legislation that overlap with the Drinking Water Directive and its national implementation must be repealed.
