5. Amendment to the Provincial Government Regulation laying down the structural requirements for buildings and specifying the content and form of the energy performance certificate and the renovation certificate (Technical Building Regulations 2026 – TBV 2026)

6. Installation of emergency lighting, fitting out of battery rooms for stationary battery systems and garages, as well as simplified procedures for existing buildings and changes to the intended use of such buildings

8. Re: emergency lighting:

Prior to the publication of OVE 8101, the installation of emergency lighting restricted to escape routes was governed by TRVB 102E (escape route orientation lighting). Following the appearance of the above-mentioned OVE, the TRVB 102E was withdrawn. The OVE 8101 now provides for much stricter requirements and there are hardly any differences between emergency lighting and fully fledged emergency lighting systems. For this reason, clarification is provided as to which areas must be illuminated and marked by emergency lighting.

Battery rooms for stationary battery installations:

The amendment includes fire protection simplifications in the technical requirements for battery rooms with regard to the expansion of renewable energy and its storage.

Garages:

The amendment introduces relaxed fire safety requirements for the construction of garages with covered parking spaces up to a total area of 120 m².

9. Given the limited available land for development in Tyrol, the conservation of land is the top priority for political efforts in the province. For this reason, this amendment is intended to provide a further incentive for renovation work on existing buildings and thus help to curb further land sealing.

9a. Re point 1) There is no risk to the objective, which is in the public interest, of creating further incentives for renovation of existing buildings.

ad point 2) Certain facilitations (e.g. in the area of fire protection) are provided to make it easier to adapt existing buildings.

Re: point 3) Yes, thanks to a number of facilitations (fire safety, facilitations regarding technical requirements, etc.).

9b. Re point 1): Restrictions are indirect and only to a very limited extent, as the scope of application of technical regulations (e.g. relating to fire safety) is changing (deviations in existing buildings).

re point 2) Yes, this is the least restrictive measure.

re point 3) Retention of existing TBV

ad point 4) Because this would not achieve the objective of the TBV amendment.

Re point 5) It is the only possible measure.

9c. Re point 1) Yes, especially as these are mostly facilitations anyway.

Re point 2) Barriers to trade are only theoretically conceivable anyway; facilitations clearly predominate.
Re point 3) no assessment possible
