8. The amendment is made pursuant to the Act to Accelerate the Expansion of Renewable Energy (EABG), published on 1 July 2026 – Federal Law Gazette (BGBl.). I No. 47/2026, which concerns the acceleration of the expansion of facilities for the generation, storage and distribution of energy from renewable sources. The noise emission limit values for air source heat pumps set out in Annex I point 13(b) differ from the permissible limit values currently provided for in the TGHKV 2024, which is why an adjustment is to be made in the present draft Ordinance.

9. The background to the present amendment is the deviating limit values for noise emissions from air-source heat pumps in the EABG, BGBl. I No 47/2026, compared to those currently in the TGHKV 2024, Provincial Law Gazette (LGBI.). No. 57/2024 as published in the LGBI. No. 57/2026, the values specified therein.

9a. Re point 1): There is no risk to the objective, which is in the public interest, of complying with noise emission levels in relation to air source heat pumps.

Re point 2) Link to the Act to Accelerate the Expansion of Renewable Energy – setting of limit values.

Re point 3) Yes.

9b. Re point 1): Restrictions are indirect and only to a very limited extent, as additional specifications apply in relation to air-source heat pumps.

re point 2) Yes, this is the least restrictive measure.

ad point 3) None, because none exists.

ad point 4) See point 3.

Re point 5) It is the only possible measure; based on the EABG.

9c. Re point 1): Yes.

Re point 2) Barriers to trade are, in any case, only conceivable in theory; no further assessment is required as this is a matter for the federal legislature.

ad point 3) Requirement EABG.
