

ROMANIAN BUREAU OF LEGAL METROLOGY

ORDER No

amending and supplementing Order No 77/2022 of the Director-General of the Romanian Bureau of Legal Metrology approving the Official list of measuring instruments subject to legal metrological control LO – 2022, as subsequently amended and supplemented

Pursuant to Government Order No 20/1992 on metrology activity, approved and amended by Law No 11/1994, as amended,

In accordance with Government Decision No 193/2002 regarding the organisation and operation of the Romanian Bureau of Legal Metrology, as subsequently amended and supplemented,

The Director-General of the Romanian Bureau of Legal Metrology issues the following order:

Article I. – Annex to Order No 77/2022 of the Director-General of the Romanian Bureau of Legal Metrology approving the Official list of measuring instruments subject to legal metrological control LO – 2022, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 332 of 5 April 2022, as subsequently amended and supplemented, is amended and supplemented as follows:

1. Item No 10, position L33 is reworded to read as follows:

2. In the Annex, footnote 10 to the table is reworded to read as follows:

¹⁰ Turbine gas meters with maximum flow from 2 500 m³/h up to and including 6 500 m³/h, in use, that were made available on the market and put into service prior to the date of entry into force of this order in compliance with Government Decision No 711/2015 shall be submitted for the first periodic metrological verification within a maximum of eight years of the date of putting into service. Turbine gas meters with a maximum flow with maximum flow from 2 500 m³/h up to and including 6 500 m³/h, in use, that were made available on the market and put into service prior to the date of entry into force of this order without compliance with Government Decision No 711/2015, shall be submitted directly for metrological verification by 1 December 2027.'

3. After footnote ⁽²⁶⁾ a footnote ⁽²⁷⁾ is inserted, worded as follows:

²⁷ Ultrasonic gas meters that were made available on the market and put into service prior to the date of entry into force of this order without compliance with Government Decision No 711/2015 shall not be accepted for metrological verification, whether periodic or following repair. Ultrasonic gas meters, in use, that were made available on the market and put into service prior to the date of entry into force of this order in compliance with Government Decision No 711/2015 shall be submitted for the first periodic metrological verification within a maximum of eight years of the date of putting into service.

Article II. - This order has been adopted in accordance with the notification procedure laid down by Directive (EU) 2015/1535 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 September 2015 laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical regulations and of rules on Information Society services, which was transposed into Romanian law by Government Decision No 1016/2004 on measures for the organisation and implementation of the exchange of information in the field of technical standards and regulations and of the rules on Information Society services between Romania and the Member States of the European Union, as well as the European Commission, as subsequently amended and supplemented.

Article III. - This order shall be published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I and shall enter into force 30 days after its date of publication.
