5. Ordinance amending the Veterinary Pharmacy Ordinance and other provisions

6. These provisions will streamline national legislation on veterinary medicines: In particular, national regulations that have been in force to date are being repealed and superseded by new, directly applicable provisions of EU law.

8. The national legislation currently in force regarding prohibitions on repurposing antibiotics and the

legislation on good manufacturing practice for veterinary medicinal products will be brought into line with directly applicable Community law.

In addition, the reporting requirements for animal owners and veterinarians (which used to be semi-annual) will be reduced to annual reports as part of the national antibiotic reduction strategy.

9. Implementing Regulation (EU) 2024/1973 contains restrictions and prohibitions on the reclassification of different antimicrobial groups of active substances and related obligations for the implementation of antibiograms. Certain national provisions previously in force under the Veterinary Pharmacy Ordinance (TÄHAV) regarding the implementation of antibiograms in the reclassification of medicinal products containing antibiotics will be superseded by these directly applicable Community provisions.

Implementing Regulations (EU) 2025/2091 and (EU) 2025/2154, which establish good manufacturing practices for veterinary medicinal products and their starting materials, supersede the national provisions of the Ordinance on the Application of Good Manufacturing Practice in the Manufacture of Veterinary Medicinal Products and Active Substances (TAMWHV).

The amendment to the Ordinance on the Use of Antibiotic Medicinal Products required due to the notification obligations as amended in Article 2 of the Act amending the Veterinary Medicinal Products Act and the Pharmacy Act of 22 December 2025.

Furthermore, the amendments to the Veterinary Pharmacy Ordinance and the Ordinance on the Application of Good Manufacturing Practice in the Manufacture of Veterinary Medicinal Products and Active Substances help reduce bureaucracy.

9a. The proposed rules are suitable for supporting the objectives pursued by the draft bill. In particular, the alignments with current EU law and the revision of national legislation on veterinary medicinal products to improve clarity and transparency contribute to greater traceability and safety in the handling of veterinary medicinal products.

9b. The provisions are necessary in order to adapt national law to the directly applicable legislation in EU law.

9c. The provisions comply with European legislation and contribute to maintaining the existing high level of protection while safeguarding the economic viability of animal husbandry.
