- 5. Draft Decree amending Decree No 516/2020 on requirements for fuels and implementation of certain other provisions of the Fuels Act

The draft Decree reduces the minimum number of fuel samples taken per year for the assessment of their standard and quality, as proposed by the Czech Trade Inspection Authority, in response to the long-term improvement in fuel quality. The aim is to reduce the costs incurred by the Czech Trade Inspection Authority for monitoring the standard and quality of fuels. Even after this reduction, the minimum number of samples taken remains significantly higher than that required by European regulations. In order to eliminate the risk of deterioration in the standard and quality of fuels, rules are set for a possible temporary increase in the minimum number of samples, depending on the results of monitoring in the annual period under assessment.

Another objective is to update the Decree in accordance with the applicable European technical standards regarding the quality indicators monitored for selected fuels.

Decree No 516/2020 was adopted on 4 December 2020 and took effect on 1 January 2021, with the exception of § 3(1)(n), which took effect on 12 November 2021. The draft Decree was the subject of Notification 2020/0332/CZ. The current version of the Decree, effective from 12 November 2021, has been uploaded to the TRIS database.

This Decree incorporates the relevant legislation of the European Union:

- Directive 98/70/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 October 1998 relating to the quality of petrol and diesel fuels and amending Council Directive 93/12/EEC.
- Commission Directive 2000/71/EC of 7 November 2000 to adapt the measuring methods as laid down in Annexes I, II, III and IV to Directive 98/70/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council to technical progress as foreseen in Article 10 of that Directive.
- Commission Decision 2002/159/EC of 18 February 2002 on a common format for the submission of summaries of national fuel quality data.
- Directive 2003/17/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 3 March 2003 amending Directive 98/70/EC relating to the quality of petrol and diesel fuels.
- Directive 2003/30/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 8 May 2003 on the promotion of the use of biofuels or other renewable fuels for transport.
- Directive 2009/30/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 April 2009 amending Directive 98/70/EC as regards the specification of petrol, diesel and gas-oil and introducing a mechanism to monitor and reduce greenhouse gas emissions and amending Council Directive 1999/32/EC as regards the specification of fuel used by inland waterway vessels and repealing Directive 93/12/EEC.
- Directive 2014/94/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 October 2014 on the deployment of alternative fuels infrastructure, as replaced by Regulation (EU) 2023/1804 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 13 September 2023.
- Commission Directive 2014/77/EU of 10 June 2014 amending Annexes I and II of Directive 98/70/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council relating to the quality of petrol and diesel fuels.

- Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2019/1745 of 13 August 2019 supplementing and amending Directive 2014/94/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards charging points for L-category motor vehicles, shore-side electricity supply for inland waterway vessels, hydrogen supply for road transport and natural gas supply for road and waterborne transport and repealing Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2018/674.

The Decree implements the provisions of § 3(2), § 4(1), § 5(6) and § 7(3) of Act No 311/2006 on fuels and filling stations and on amendments to certain related acts (Fuels Act) (hereinafter the 'basic act'), which was adopted on 23 May 2006 and came into effect 1 September 2006. The Act was subsequently amended many times, most recently by Act No 284/2021, effective from 1 January 2024. Neither the original text of the basic act nor any of its amendments has been notified under TRIS. Only the draft Decree subsequently approved as Decree No 516/2020, which repealed the original Decree No 133/2010 and was adopted in connection with a prior amendment to the basic act through Act No 48/2020, was notified (Notification 2020/0332/CZ). The current version of the Act, effective from 1 January 2024, has been uploaded to the TRIS database.
