

Government Decree

amending section 1b of the Firearms Decree (145/1998)

By decision of the Government,
Section 1b of the Firearms Decree (145/1998), as amended by Decree 572/2011, *is amended*
as follows:

Section 1b

Affixing markings

The manufacturing, supplementary and import marking of a firearm referred to in section 110a of the Firearms Act (1/1998) is also deemed to have been affixed to a visible place if it can be read from a firearm which has been dismantled for the purpose of maintenance carried out by a user.

The marking shall be affixed using Latin characters and Arabic numerals with a depth of at least 0.0762 millimetres and a height of at least 1.6 millimetres. A marking on a firearm component may be affixed using characters and numbers smaller than 1.6 millimetres if it is necessary due to the small size of the component.

For non-metal receivers, the marking shall be affixed to a metal plate that has been permanently embedded in the material of the receiver in such a way that the plate cannot be easily removed and removal would destroy a part of the receiver.

The Finnish country code for the import marking is FI.
