5. Quality Assurance for Food Products (QAFP)

6. The Quality Assurance for Food Products (QAFP) scheme is multi-product in nature, including pig meat, poultry meat and dried, salted and smoked meat made of poultry, pork and beef.

The draft contains a description of the voluntary national agricultural product quality scheme in accordance with the criteria set out in Article 47(a) of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2022/126 of 7 December 2021 supplementing Regulation (EU) 2021/2115 of the European Parliament and of the Council with additional requirements for certain types of intervention specified by Member States in their CAP Strategic Plans for the period 2023 to 2027 under that Regulation, as well as rules on the ratio for the good agricultural and environmental condition (GAEC) standard 1.

The proposed changes to the scheme concern pigs and pig meat. The draft extends the possibility of reproductive selection of piglets accepted for fattening within the same breeds. The extension of the scheme consists in the addition of three breeds (Puławska, Żłotnicka Biała, Żłotnicka Pstra).
The proposed extension will also increase the availability of the scheme among farmers.

The requirements of the QAFP scheme have been developed by a group of producers who will implement them. Participation in the scheme is voluntary. All entities that fulfil the requirements set out in the standards of the scheme are entitled to participate in the scheme.

9. The draft has been prepared taking into account the information provided by the Directorate-General for Agriculture and Rural Development of the European Commission, according to which the Ministry of Agriculture and Rural Development has been informed of the legal obligation to notify draft national quality schemes for agricultural products and foodstuffs, in accordance with the procedures laid down in Directive (EU) 2015/1535 of the European Parliament and of the Council.
