5. Regulation of the Provincial Government of Upper Austria amending the Upper Austrian Construction Engineering Regulation 2013

(Upper Austrian Construction Engineering Amendment 2025)

6. Construction products, e.g. photovoltaic systems, façade greening, charging stations for electric vehicles

8. The amendment to the Upper Austrian Construction Engineering Regulation 2013 pursues the following objectives:

- the implementation of new Guidelines 1 to 5 of the Austrian Institute of Construction Engineering (OIB) (the 'OIB Guidelines'), May 2023 edition, which reflect the current status of the construction engineering regulations that are harmonised between the provinces;
- timely amendments and clarifications based on experience in administrative practice.

The aforementioned OIB Guidelines have already been communicated under notification No 2023/602/AT.

9. The current revision of the OIB Guidelines focused in particular on including provisions to combat climate change, such as photovoltaic systems and greening on roofs and façades; on making it easier to reduce construction costs in order to promote affordable housing; and on clarifications and specifications to ensure consistent enforcement in the provinces. Decarbonisation and the associated promotion of alternative energy sources, in particular photovoltaic systems on buildings, is becoming increasingly important, which is why it was necessary to integrate regulations on preventive fire protection.
