LAW OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA AMMENDING ARTICLES 4, 8, 10 AND 12 OF THE LAW ON SUPERVISION OF POTENTIALLY DANGEROUS EQUIPMENT NO. I-1324

No of 2025 Vilnius

Article 1. Amendment to Article 4

Article 4(1) shall be rescinded.

Article 2. Amendment to Article 8

Article 8 is amended to read as follows:

'Article 8. Register of Potentially Dangerous Equipment

- 1. The object of the Register of Potentially Dangerous Equipment (hereinafter referred to as the 'Register') is potentially dangerous equipment. The information system of the Register of Potentially Dangerous Equipment (hereinafter referred to as the 'Information System of the Register') shall manage the data sets on potentially dangerous equipment, the owners of potentially dangerous equipment and the supervision of potentially dangerous equipment. The specific data contained in the sets of data processed in the Information System of the Register shall be determined in the Regulations on the Information System of the Register.
- 2. The State Labour Inspectorate of the Republic of Lithuania under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour (hereinafter 'the SLI') is the operator of the Information System of the Register and the controller of the Register's data, including personal data.
- 3. A potentially dangerous piece of equipment shall be registered in the Information System of the Register under an application submitted by the owner of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment or its authorised representative, where the following conditions are fulfilled:
- 1) the potentially dangerous piece of equipment is owned or operated, used and disposed of by the right of trust;
- 2) there is a valid contract with an accredited body for the inspection of the technical condition of a potentially dangerous piece of equipment;
- 3) there is a valid (before the date of the next inspection of the technical condition of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment) conclusion of the accredited body that the potentially dangerous piece of equipment is suitable for use and safe for human life, health or the environment.

- 4. A potentially dangerous piece of equipment shall be deregistered from the Information System of the Register in the following cases:
- 1) at the request submitted by the owner of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment or its authorised representative, in the cases specified in the Regulations on the Information System of the Register;
- 2) it transpires that the potentially dangerous piece of equipment has been removed from the Republic of Lithuania more than 12 months ago;
- 3) after the conclusion of the accredited body that the potentially dangerous piece of equipment is suitable for use and safe for human life, health or the environment, indicated on the date of the next inspection of the technical condition of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment, and after the operator of the Information System of the Register has warned the owner of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment of the possible deregistration of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment within 3 working days from the date of the coming inspection of the technical condition of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment, the latter fails to fulfil the obligation laid down in Article 12(2)(2) of this Law within 2 months from the date of the warning;
- 4) upon receipt of the conclusion of the accredited body that the potentially dangerous piece of equipment is unsuitable for use and unsafe for human life, health or the environment, and the non-compliances indicated cannot be remedied or the owner of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment fails to remedy the deficiencies in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 12(2)(7) of this Law;
- 5) it transpires that the owner of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment has ceased to be the legal entity or the natural person has died or has been declared deceased by court, and/or there is no information concerning the further use, location or destruction of the potentially dangerous piece of equipment, and it is not possible to obtain this information by means available to the operator of the Information System of the Register.
- 5. The data in the Information System of the Register, with the exception of personal data, shall be public. The provision of data from the Information System of the Register shall be subject to the restrictions referred to in Article 28(11) of the Law of the Republic of Lithuania on the Management of State Information Resources, the principles defined in Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) and the conditions for lawful processing of personal data laid down in Article 6, and taking into account the specificities of processing

personal identification numbers laid down in Article 3 of the Law of the Republic of Lithuania on the Legal Protection of Personal Data.

- 6. Data processed in the Information System of the Register shall be made available for reuse, with the exception of personal data, data relating to public safety and security and data constituting the confidential information of a legal person or which may reveal its commercial (business) secrets.
- 7. The aggregated statistical data of the Information System of the Register shall be included in the report referred to in Article 6(4) of this Law.'

§ 3. Amendment to Article 10

Article 10(2)(4) shall be amended to read as follows:

'4) to provide data on the inspection of the technical condition of potentially dangerous equipment and data on contracts with owners of potentially dangerous equipment for the inspection of the technical condition of potentially dangerous equipment in accordance with the procedure and within the time limits laid down in the Regulations on the Information System of the Register;'.

§ 4. Amendment to Article 12

- 1. Article 12(2)(3) shall be amended to read as follows:
- '3) use only a potentially dangerous piece of equipment registered in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Regulations on the Information System of the Register and having a valid conclusion of an accredited body that the potentially dangerous piece of equipment is suitable for use and safe for human life, health or the environment;'.
 - 2. Article 12(2)(4) shall be amended to read as follows:
- '(4) Provide the Register Data to the data processor of the Information System of the Register in accordance with the procedure laid down in the Regulations of the Information System of the Register;".

§ 5. Entry into force and implementation of the Law

- 1. This law, with the exception of paragraph 2 of this Article, enters into force on 1 January 2027.
- 2. The Government of the Republic of Lithuania, the Chief State Labour Inspector of the State Labour Inspectorate under the Ministry of Social Security and Labour of the Republic of Lithuania, the Minister for Social Security and Labour, the Minister for Transport and Communications, the Minister for the Economy and Innovation, the Minister for the Environment

and the Minister for Energy shall adopt the implementing legislation in respect of this Law by 31 December 2026.
