5. Draft Law amending Articles 4, 8, 10 and 12 of Law No I-1324 of the Republic of Lithuania on the Supervision of Potentially Dangerous Equipment

6. Potentially dangerous equipment shall mean equipment specified in the Law on the Supervision of

Potentially Dangerous Equipment and complying with the parameters approved by the Government and the use of which, due to the processes taking place in them, poses a risk to the well-being of people and the environment.

The draft Law amending Articles 4, 8, 10 and 12 of Law No I-1324 of the Republic of Lithuania on the Supervision of Potentially Dangerous Equipment waives the powers for the Government of the Republic of Lithuania to establish the State Register of Potentially Dangerous Equipment (hereinafter 'the PDE Register'), approve its regulations and appoint its registrar; regulates the provisions of the PDE Register and the information system of the PDE Register, defines the concept of the PDE Register, objects, data sets of the PDE Register, specifies the data of the PDE Register, including personal data and the operator of the information system of the PDE Register; provides for the grounds and conditions for the registration (registration and deregistration) of potentially dangerous equipment in the information system of the PDE Register. Other amendments of a technical nature are also being made in order to bring concepts and legal regulation into line with Law No XI-1807 of the Republic of Lithuania on the Management of State Information Resources.

The Law shall enter into force on 1 January 2027.

9. The Draft Law amending Articles 4, 8, 10 and 12 of Law No I-1324 on the Supervision of Potentially Dangerous Equipment has been drawn up in implementation of Law No XIV-2436 of the Republic of Lithuania amending Law No XI-1807 of 21 December 2023 on the Management of State Information Resources, which entered into force on 1 January 2024 (hereinafter referred to as the 'LMSIR Amending Law'), which recasts the Law of the Republic of Lithuania on the Management of State Information Resources. As a result of the implementation of the LMSIR Amending Law, the obligation arose to insert the provisions, some of which are now set out in the Regulations of the Register of Potentially Dangerous Equipment, into the Law of the Republic of Lithuania on the Supervision of Potentially Dangerous Equipment: to specify the data set or data sets composing the register to be created, the operator of the information system of the register and the data controller, to establish restrictions on the provision of personal data, if any, as well as the grounds and conditions for the registration of register objects and other related provisions. The right to draw up and adopt regulations for all types of information systems is reserved for the information system operator.
