**Order of
extending the ‘Electric Private Vehicles’ incentive within the framework of the Energy Savings
Certificates scheme**

NOR:

Target audience: *beneficiaries and applicants within the framework of the Energy Savings Certificates scheme.*

Purpose: *this order extends the ‘Electric Private Vehicles’ incentive, which increases the fixed amount of the standardised operation sheet TRA-EQ-117 relating to new light vehicles of category M1 for individuals.*

Entry into force: *this order enters into force on 1 January 2026.*

Application: *this order amends the order of 29 December 2014, relating to the implementing provisions of the Energy Savings Certificates scheme.*

The Minister for the Economy, Finance, and Industrial, Energy and Digital Sovereignty,

Having regard to the Energy Code, in particular Articles R. 221-14 and R. 221-18 thereof;

Having regard to the Order of 29 December 2014 relating to the implementing provisions of the energy savings certificates scheme;

Having regard to the opinion of the High Council for Energy of 4 December 2025;

Having regard to the observations made during the public consultation held from XX November to XX December 2025 pursuant to Article L. 123-19-1 of the Environment Code;

Having regard to Notification No. XX addressed to the European Commission on XX 2025,

Hereby orders:

Article 1

The aforementioned order of 29 December 2014 is amended as follows:

I.- In paragraphs 1 and 2 of section VIII of Article 3-7-3, the words: “committed until 31 December 2025 inclusive and completed before 30 June 2026,” are deleted.

II.- In Annex XIV, the words: “and no later than 31 December 2025, and completed no later than 30 June 2026” are deleted.

Article 2

This order shall enter into force on 1 January 2026.

Article 3

The Director of Climate, Energy Efficiency and Air is responsible for the implementation of this order, which shall be published in the Official Journal of the French Republic.
