

## GOVERNMENT

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**decree**

**amending Government Decree No 508/2017 of 29 December 2017 on the rules of the making and decoration of precious metal articles**

[1] Hallmarking is an important means of making the marketing of precious metal articles safer. The renewal of the hallmark series greatly contributes to making it more difficult to counterfeit precious metal articles.

[2] Pursuant to the authorisation granted under Section 12(1)(j) of Act CLXIV of 2005 on trade, and acting within its scope of duties as defined in Article 15(1) of the Fundamental Law, the Government hereby decrees the following:

### **Section 1**

In Government Decree No 508/2017 of 29 December 2017 on official duties and official procedural rules relating to articles of precious metal and on the rules of the making and decoration of precious metal articles (hereinafter: Government Decree No 508/2017 of 29 December), Annex 3 is replaced by Annex 1 hereto.

### **Section 2**

This Decree shall enter into force on the eighth day following its publication.

### **Section 3**

The requirement for the prior notification of this draft decree, as stipulated in Articles 5 to 7 of Directive (EU) 2015/1535 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 September 2015 laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical regulations and of rules on Information Society services, has been met.

*“Annex 3 to Government Decree No 508/2017 of 29 December 2017*

### **Hallmarks in Hungary for precious metal articles subject to the hallmarking obligation**

1. The description of the hallmarks is as follows:

1.1. for platinum items with a fineness of 950 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a sword, above which is the letter denoting the year, and above the letter denoting the year is 950; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.2. for platinum items with a fineness of 900 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a sword, with the letter of the year below it and 900 below the letter of the year; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.3. for palladium items with a fineness of 950 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a helmet, with the letter of the year on the left and 950 on the right; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.4. for palladium items with a fineness of 500 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a helmet, with the letter of the year on the left and 500 on the right; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.5. for gold items with a fineness of 916 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a crown, with the letter of the year and 916 underneath, and a stylised sun on the right; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.6. for gold items with a fineness of 750 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a crown, with the letter of the year and 750 underneath, and a stylised sun on the right; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.7. for gold items with a fineness of 585 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a sacred crown, with a stylised sun on the left, the letter denoting the year to the left of the sun, and 585 below the letter denoting the year and the sun; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.8. for gold items with a fineness of 375 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a crown, with the letter of the year and 375 underneath; a stylised sun on the right; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.9. for silver items with a fineness of 925 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a stylised bridge (Chain Bridge) with the letter of the year above it; above the letter of the year, the number 925; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.10. for silver items with a fineness of 900 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a stylised bridge (Elizabeth Bridge) with the letter of the year and 900 above it; the mark is multi-level in depth;

1.11. for silver items with a fineness of 835 parts per thousand, as specified in Annex 1, a stylised bridge (Veszprém viaduct) with the letter of the year and 835 underneath; the mark is multi-level in depth;

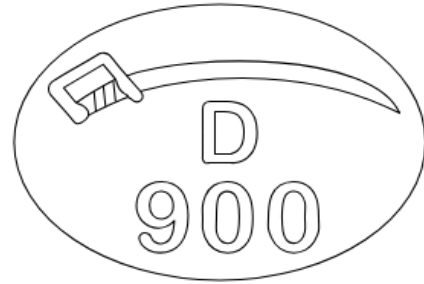
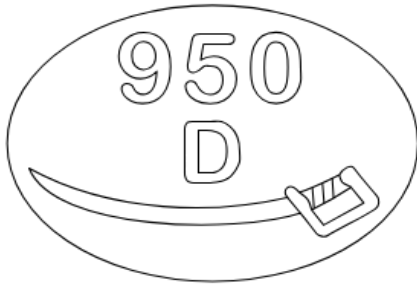
1.12. for silver items with a fineness of 800 parts per thousand, as defined in Annex 1, a stylised bridge (Liberty Bridge) with the letter of the year underneath and 800 above it; the mark is multi-level in depth.

2. The shape and drawing of the office mark and the hallmarks are as follows:

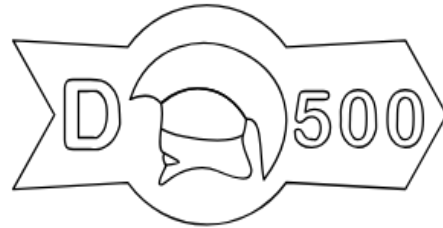
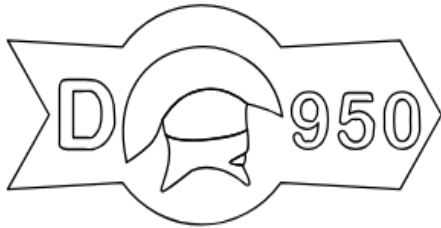
2.1. Office mark (Authority mark)



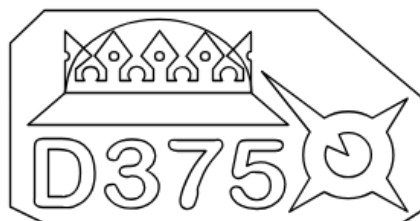
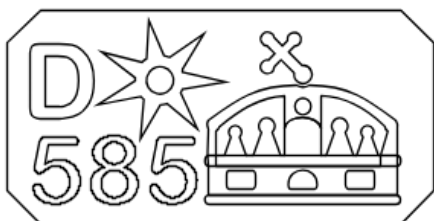
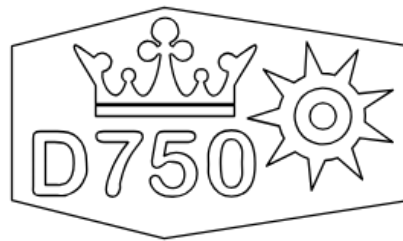
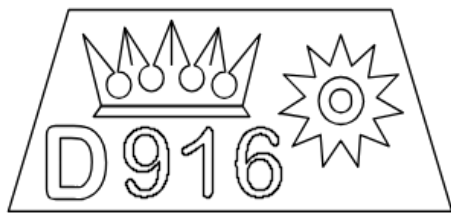
