8. The new law means that a state electronic ID will be introduced.

Within the Kingdom, the state electronic ID shall be issued by the Swedish Police Authority and, outside the Kingdom, by diplomatic missions and consular posts, to the extent determined by the Government or the

authority designated by the Government.

It is also proposed that in their online services, public operators should in certain cases recognise electronic identification means, such as electronic IDs, that are provided within the framework of an authorisation system in accordance with the Act (2023:704) on authorisation systems for services for electronic identification and for digital mail.

The state electronic ID will be connected to an authorisation system in accordance with the Act on authorisation systems for services for electronic identification and for digital mail. It will then be included in the services for electronic identification covered by the proposed requirement in Chapter 4, Section 1 of the Act on a state electronic ID and electronic identification. The assurance level provided by the state electronic ID will be high in accordance with Regulation (EU) No 910/2014 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 July 2014 on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market and repealing Directive 1999/93/EC, hereinafter referred to as the 'EU Regulation on electronic identification'.

Requirements notified

The draft act means, among other things, that public actors must in certain cases recognise electronic identification means for authentication in their online services (Chapter 4, Section 1 D). According to the regulation, public actors must recognise electronic identification means provided within the framework of an authorisation system in accordance with the Act on authorisation systems for services for electronic identification and for digital mail. The requirement shall apply where an electronic identification means is required to access an online service and the service is wholly or partly addressed to individuals. The requirement applies only if the assurance level for the means corresponds to an assurance level that is equal to or higher than the assurance level that the public operator requires for access to the online service. A public operator is, for example, a private operator that professionally carries out activities that are to some extent publicly funded in certain designated areas, such as healthcare under the Health and Medical Services Act (2017:30).

9. The development of society is characterised in several respects by digitalisation, and it is increasingly important to be able to identify electronically in order to be able to take part in society's functions. The EU Regulation on electronic identification further requires Member States to provide a digital identity wallet. In order for users to be able to access such a wallet, either an electronic ID at the highest assurance level or an electronic ID at assurance level 'substantial' in combination with so-called reinforcement measures is required. The proposal to introduce a state electronic ID with the assurance level 'high' aims to secure society's access to electronic identification and to meet the requirements of the EU Regulation on electronic identification.
