5. REGULATION on the restriction of CMR 1A/1B substances in childcare articles

6. Childcare articles: cots, mattresses, carrycots, hygiene kits and certain soft pads, bottles, spoons, bowls, teats, teethers

8. The Regulation is part of a transitional period during which the EU is preparing a uniform restriction on CMR substances in childcare articles under REACH Article 68(2), which the European Commission has

formally requested from ECHA (European Chemicals Agency).

The main objective of the Regulation is to prevent the exposure of children to CMR 1A/1B substances that have been shown to be carcinogenic, mutagenic or toxic for reproduction. In its investigation report, ECHA confirmed the presence of these substances in children's articles, e.g. seats, mattresses, hygiene products and other common items.

With this measure, Slovenia is preventing security gaps until the EU restrictions are adopted.

9. The Regulation temporarily restricts the presence of carcinogenic, mutagenic and reprotoxic substances of category 1A or 1B (CMR 1A/1B) in childcare articles placed on the market in the Republic of Slovenia. It is based on Articles 50 and 51 of the Chemicals Act and is adopted on the grounds of a justified risk to children's health.

The Regulation stipulates that these articles must not contain CMR 1A/1B substances in concentrations \geq 0.001% (10 mg/kg) in any homogeneous material, except where stricter limits are prescribed for specific substances. Exceptions are also provided for: second-hand products, parts that are inaccessible to children, and medical devices.

The Regulation defines the concept of childcare articles, the obligations of manufacturers, importers and distributors, and the means of control, which include the requirement for technical documentation and laboratory analyses.

The measure is temporary and, in accordance with the law, the Government must review it within one year at the latest and, on the basis of new findings, decide whether to abolish, extend or amend it.
