'(1) Pursuant to Article 10(2) of Regulation (EU) 2017/625, the Minister is authorised to establish a register of operators, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), as amended, and with the provisions of the Law of 1 August 2018 on the organisation of the National Commission for Data Protection and the General Data Protection Regime.  
(2) A Grand-Ducal regulation shall lay down detailed terms for the application of this Article.'
