



Draft law amending the Law of 8 September 2022 establishing and organising the Luxembourg Veterinary and Food Administration (ALVA)

We, Guillaume, Grand Duke of Luxembourg, Duke of Nassau,

Having heard the Council of State;

Having considered the adoption by the Chamber of Deputies;

Having regard to the decision of the Chamber of Deputies of ... and that of the Council of State of ... stating that there is no need for a second vote;

Have ordered and do hereby order:

Article 1.

Article 2(1) of the Law of 8 September 2022 establishing and organising the Luxembourg Veterinary and Food Administration is amended as follows:

- 1° In the introductory sentence, the words 'The ALVA shall be responsible for the following tasks within the limits laid down by laws and regulations: ' are replaced by the words: 'Within the limits laid down by laws and regulations and in so far as legal or regulatory provisions do not confer competence on other State bodies, administrations or departments, the ALVA shall have the following powers: '.
- 2° Following point 14 of the ALVA's powers, a new point 15 is added, worded as follows: '15 conducting checks falling within the remit of the ALVA, in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2023/1115 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 31 May 2023 on the placing on the Union market and the export from the Union of certain commodities and products associated with deforestation and forest degradation, and repealing Regulation (EU) No 995/2010. '.

Article 2.

Following paragraph 2 of Article 2 of the same law, a new paragraph 3 is added, worded as follows:

'(3) Any decision relating to registers containing personal data, administrative measures and penalties shall be taken by the Minister in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations.

All decisions regarding approval are made by the Minister, with the ALVA being asked for its opinion. '.
