8. The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish binding requirements for the interoperability of information technology systems in hospitals. Clear technical and organisational specifications are to be established in order to create uniform standards that enable secure, structured and automated communication between

information technology systems within hospitals, as well as with other actors in the healthcare sector. More specifically, Annex 1 to the IOP Governance Ordinance sets out binding requirements for the implementation of the Information Technology Systems in Hospitals (ISiK) standard. ISiK is a uniform and module-based interface for the exchange of data between information technology systems in hospitals which enables communication between various systems.

9. Uniform requirements are to be established so that data can be collected, processed and transferred in a structured manner in compliance with the standard. This will help avoid duplicate inputs and potential transmission errors between the IT systems, thus optimising administrative and clinical processes and significantly improving the quality of care in the treatment of patients.
