## Ordinance concerning the electric car premium

[Issued on xx December 2025]

The Swedish Government hereby lays down<sup>1</sup> the following.

### Introductory provisions

**Section 1** This Ordinance contains provisions stating that the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency may provide a subsidy in the form of an electric car bonus to anyone who purchases or starts leasing an electric car.

**Section 2** This Ordinance is issued by virtue of

- Chapter 8, Section 11 of the Instrument of Government with respect to Section 35, and
- Chapter 8, Section 7 of the Instrument of Government with respect to other provisions.

### Terms and definitions

**Section 3** For the purposes of this Ordinance, the following definitions shall apply:

*electric car*: a class I passenger car in accordance with the Act (2001:559) on road traffic definitions, that are classified in emission class ‘E1’ (Electric) in accordance with Section 32 of the Exhaust Gas Treatment Act (2011:318);

*household*: persons who, according to the Population Registration Act (1991:481), are to be regarded as residing at the same property and, if the property has several residential apartments, in the same apartment;

*plug-in hybrid*: a class I passenger car in accordance with the Act on road traffic definitions, that are classified in emission class ‘Laddhybrid’ (Plug-in hybrid) in accordance with Section 32 of the Exhaust Gas Treatment Act;

*leasing*: the hire of a car for a fixed term of at least one year;

*national average of adjusted taxable income*: the average value to be determined annually by the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency in accordance with Section 36;

*taxable income*: determined earned income and capital surplus or deficit; and

*the Swedish Road Traffic Register*: the register referred to in Chapter 2, Section 1 of the Road Traffic Data Act (2019:369).

*A relative* means:

1. a person who is a spouse, cohabiting partner, child, stepchild, foster child, parent, grandparent or sibling of the applicant or of a person living in the applicant's household;
2. a person who is the spouse, cohabiting partner or child of a person referred to in 1; or
3. an estate of a deceased person of which the applicant or someone specified in 1 or 2 is a partner.

### **Requirements for granting an electric car premium**

**Section 4** An electric car premium may, if funds are available, be granted to anyone who purchases or starts leasing an electric car, provided that the conditions in Sections 5 to 17 are met.

**Section 5** If the applicant has purchased or started leasing the electric car before the application for an electric car premium is made, the applicant shall have been registered as owner or holder of the electric car in the Swedish Road Traffic Register no earlier than two months before the application has been received by the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency.

**Section 6** An electric car premium may be granted if the adjusted total income of the applicant's household is no more than 80 per cent of the most recently determined national average of adjusted taxable income.

**Section 7** The household's total income shall consist of the sum of the taxable income determined in the most recent final tax assessment for each person in the household who is 20 years of age or older, unless otherwise specified in Section 8.

The total household income shall be adjusted to take account of the composition of the household by dividing it by the total consumption weight of the household. Unless otherwise provided for in Section 8, the individual consumption weight of the household is:

- 1.00 for the first adult aged 20 years or older;
- 0.51 for the second adult aged 20 years or older;
- 0.60 for each additional adult aged 20 years or older;
- 0.52 for the first child aged 0–17 years who has at least one legal guardian in the household;
- 0.42 for each additional child aged 0–17 years who has at least one legal guardian in the household;
- 0.52 for the first young adult aged 18 or 19 years; and
- 0.42 for each additional young adult aged 18 or 19 years.

**Section 8** If the applicant for an electric car premium is 18 or 19 years of age

4. the applicant's taxable income according to the last available final tax assessment is included in the calculation of the household's total income pursuant to Section 7, first paragraph, and

5. the applicant is considered to be an adult for the purposes of calculating the total consumption weight of the household in accordance with Section 7, second paragraph.

**Section 9** The applicant, or another person in the applicant's household who is 20 years or older, must not have been charged state income tax in accordance with the latest available final tax assessment.

**Section 10** The applicant shall reside in a municipality indicated in Annex 1 or on a property located in an area with limited access to public transport as specified in Annex 2.

**Section 11** The electric car must be registered in accordance with the Ordinance (2019:383) on vehicle registration and use and must not be subject to a driving ban.

**Section 12** The applicant, or anyone else in the applicant's household, may not have been registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as the holder or owner of:

6. an electric car other than the one referred to in the application; or
7. a plug-in hybrid.

**Section 13** No member of the applicant's household may be an applicant in another ongoing case under this Ordinance.

**Section 14** The price of the electric car may not be lower than SEK 64 800 and not higher than SEK 450 000.

If the electric car is leased, the monthly cost may not be less than SEK 1 800 and not higher than SEK 4 600.

**Section 15** The electric car may not:

1. have been the basis for an electric car premium previously being granted to someone in the applicant's household;
2. have been owned by a member of the applicant's household, a relative or a company in which the applicant or a member of the applicant's household has a leading position before the applicant was registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as owner or holder of the electric car; or
3. be intended for use in a commercial activity.

**Section 16** An electric car premium may only be granted once per applicant.

**Section 17** The applicant or any member of the applicant's household may not have any debts that have been handed over to the Swedish Enforcement Authority and relate to overdue taxes or contributions in accordance with:

- the Act (1976:206) on parking fines;
- the Act (2004:629) on congestion tax;
- the Act (2006:227) on road traffic tax;
- the Act (2006:228) containing special provisions on vehicle tax;
- the Act (2024:172) on infrastructure charges on roads; or
- the Ordinance (2014:1564) on infrastructure charges on roads.

### **The size of an electric car premium**

**Section 18** In addition to a monthly allowance paid in accordance with Section 26, an electric car premium may also include a start-up allowance

if the adjusted total income of the applicant's household, calculated in accordance with Sections 7 and 8, does not exceed 50 per cent of the most recently determined national average of adjusted taxable income.

**Section 19** If an application for an electric car premium has been submitted to the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency before 1 July 2028, an electric car premium may be granted:

1. with a total of SEK 46 800, paid in accordance with Section 26; and
2. with SEK 18 000 in the form of a start-up allowance in accordance with Section 18.

If the application has been submitted to the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency after 30 June 2028, an electric car premium may be granted:

1. with a total of SEK 32 400, paid in accordance with Section 26; and
2. with SEK 10 000 in the form of a start-up allowance in accordance with Section 18.

### **The examination of questions concerning the granting of an electric car premium**

**Section 20** The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency shall examine questions regarding the granting of an electric car premium.

**Section 21** Applications for an electric car premium must be made in writing and submitted electronically to the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency in the manner prescribed by the Authority. Applications must be submitted to the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency by 30 June 2029, at the latest.

**Section 22** An application for an electric car premium shall contain:

1. the applicant's name, personal identification number and contact details;
2. the registration number of the electric car, if the applicant is registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as the owner or holder of the electric car at the time of the application; and
3. a declaration on honour stating that the electric car:
  - a) is not intended for use in a commercial activity;
  - b) is not owned or has not been owned by a member of the applicant's household, a relative or a company in which the applicant or a member of the applicant's household holds a leading position before the applicant has been registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as the owner or holder of the electric car; and
  - c) has a price or monthly cost that meets the requirements in Section 14.

**Section 23** At the request of the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency, the applicant shall provide any additional documents or information necessary for the examination.

### **Decision on the granting of an electric car premium**

**Section 24** A decision to grant an electric car premium shall be subject to the following conditions:

1. that the recipient must have been resident at the same property for at least four months from the date of application and, if the property contains several residential apartments, in the same apartment in a municipality

listed in Annex 1 or in an area with limited access to public transport listed in Annex 2;

2. that the recipient shall, for a period of at least 12 months from the date of the application, reside in a municipality specified in Annex 1 or on a property located in an area with limited access to public transport as specified in Annex 2;

3. the other conditions for payment of the premium; and

4. that the recipient of the premium shall allow the European Commission, the European Anti-Fraud Office, the European Court of Auditors and the European Public Prosecutor's Office to exercise their rights, including the right to conduct investigations, on-the-spot checks and inspections, in accordance with Article 129(1) of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2024/2509 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 23 September 2024 on the financial rules applicable to the general budget of the Union.

The decision may also be subject to conditions which are otherwise necessary to meet the purpose of the premium.

**Section 25** If the applicant has not purchased or started leasing the electric car before the application is made, a decision to grant an electric car premium shall include conditions that the applicant, within the period specified by the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency, shall:

1. be registered as the owner or holder of the electric car in the Swedish Road Traffic Register; and

2. provide information on the registration number of the electric car to the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency in the manner specified by the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency.

### **Payment of an electric car premium**

**Section 26** An electric car premium shall, in the part that does not constitute a start-up allowance, be paid once a month for 36 months from the date on which the recipient was registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as the owner or holder of the electric car.

The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency may pay the premium for a period of less than 36 months, if this is necessary in order for the premium to be fully paid before 1 August 2032.

**Section 27** A start-up allowance under Section 18 shall be paid as a lump sum at the same time as the first payment is made under Section 26.

**Section 28** The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency shall decide that a granted electric car premium shall not be paid, in whole or in part, if:

1. the recipient, by making false statements or otherwise, has caused the premium to have been provided incorrectly or in an excessive amount;

2. the premium has been provided incorrectly due to the fact that the information in the Swedish Road Traffic Register is incorrect;

3. the recipient is no longer registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as the owner or holder of the electric car;

4. the premium has been paid incorrectly for some other reason and the recipient should have realised this; or

5. a condition for the premium has not been met.

## **Repayment liability**

**Section 29** The recipient of a electric car premium paid shall be liable for repayment if the aid should not have been paid out following an assessment pursuant to Section 28.

However, the recipient shall not be liable for repayment of aid paid under Section 26, if:

1. the reason why the aid should not have been paid is that the recipient has moved; and
2. the payment was made before the beneficiary moved.

**Section 30** The recipient shall be obliged to:

1. in addition to what is stated in Section 29, repay part of a paid start-up allowance if the recipient is not registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as the owner or holder of the electric car for a continuous period of twelve months from the date on which the application was made; or
2. only partially repay a paid start-up allowance that is to be repaid pursuant to Section 29, if the reason that the aid should not have been paid is that the recipient has moved.

The repayment liability applies to the portion of the start-up allowance corresponding to the period from when the applicant moved or is no longer registered in the Swedish Road Traffic Register as the owner or holder of the electric car until twelve months from when the application for the electric car premium was submitted to the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency.

## **Recovery**

**Section 31** If the recipient of an electric car premium is liable for repayment in accordance with Sections 29 or 30, the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency shall decide to demand repayment of the premium, either in whole or in part.

Interest shall be paid on the amount that a beneficiary is required to repay in accordance with Section 6 of the Interest Act (1975:635) from the thirtieth day after the date on which the decision on recovery was made in accordance with the first paragraph.

The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency may waive, in whole or in part, the claim for repayment or the claim for interest, if there are special reasons for doing so.

## **Control and follow-up**

**Section 32** The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency monitors compliance with the conditions for the premium.

**Section 33** At the request of the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency, the applicant shall provide the information that the Agency needs for its control and follow-up.

## **Reporting of a criminal offence**

**Section 34** The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency shall report to the Swedish Police Authority or the Swedish Economic Crime Authority if there is reason to believe that the applicant has committed:

1. an offence under Chapter 9, Sections 1, 2, 3 or 3b of the Penal Code;

2. a punishable attempt, preparation or conspiracy to commit an offence under Chapter 9, Sections 1, 3 or 3b of the Penal Code; or
3. an offence under Chapter 15, Section 10 of the Penal Code.

### **Right to issue regulations**

**Section 35** The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency may issue regulations on the enforcement of this Ordinance.

### **National average of adjusted taxable income**

**Section 36** The Swedish Environmental Protection Agency shall, each year, determine the national average of adjusted taxable income.

### **Obligation to provide information**

**Section 37** At the request of the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency, the Swedish Tax Agency shall provide the information on taxable income that the Swedish Environmental Protection Agency needs in order to examine an application for an electric car premium.

### **Appeals**

**Section 38** Section 40 of the Administrative Procedure Act (2017:900) contains provisions for lodging appeals with a general administrative court. However, decisions other than decisions under Section 28 or Section 31 may not be appealed.

  2. The Ordinance expires on 1 August 2032.
  3. However, the repealed Ordinance continues to apply to premiums granted before 1 August 2032.
