Order of

**establishing the list of medical devices for individual use that may be reconditioned
pursuant to Article L5212-1-1 of the French Public Health Code**

NOR:

**The Minister for Labour, Health, Solidarity and Family and the Minister for the
Economy, Finance and Industrial and Digital Sovereignty,**

Having regard to Directive (EU) 2015/1535 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 September 2015 laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical regulations and of rules on Information Society services;

Having regard to the Public Health Code, in particular Articles L5212-1-1 and R5212-44 thereof;

Having regard to the Social Security Code, in particular Articles L165-1 and L165-1-8 thereof;

Having regard to notification No 2025/XXXX/F addressed to the European Commission on XX/XXX/2025,

Hereby order:

Article 1

Pursuant to Article L5212-1-1 of the Public Health Code, the medical devices for individual use that may be reconditioned are as follows:

1. Medical beds (defined in Title I, Chapter 2, Section 1, Subsection 2 of the list defined in Article L165-1 of the Social Security Code);
2. Modular lifting apparatus and associated accessories (defined in Title I, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsection 1 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
3. Sticks and crutches (defined in Title I, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsection 2 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
4. Walking frames (defined in Title I, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsection 4 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);

5. Seats that can be adapted on a chassis with castors (defined in Title I, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsection 7 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
6. Apparatus for lifting patients (defined in Title I, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsection 8 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
7. Miscellaneous assistance devices (defined in Title I, Chapter 2, Section 2, Subsection 9 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1):
 - partial head support devices;
 - protective helmets for children with disabilities;
 - wheeled commode chairs with armrests and bucket;
 - bath chair for children up to their 16th birthday;
 - inclining bath chair base for children up to their 16th birthday;
 - knives, knives-forks, binders with case.
9. Standard lumbar support belts and standard belt bands (defined in Title II, Chapter 1, Section E of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
10. Cervical collars (defined in Title II, Chapter 1, Section F of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
11. Miscellaneous standard orthopaedic correction devices, with the exception of thermoformable medical devices (defined in Title II, Chapter 1, Section G of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
12. Frames (defined in Title II, Chapter 2, Section 1, Subsection 3 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
13. Visual aids for amblyopia (defined in Title II, Chapter 2, Section 3, Subsection 2 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1);
14. Hearing aids (defined in Title II, Chapter 3 of the list defined in the aforementioned Article);
15. Vehicles for persons with disabilities and any additions thereto (as defined in Title IV of the list defined in the aforementioned Article L165-1).
