5. Ministerial Decree establishing the standard procedure for the exploratory and descriptive soil

investigation under the Soil Decree of 27 October 2006

6. Conducting an exploratory and descriptive soil survey. An OBBO is carried out to identify contaminated soils and to determine the severity of soil contamination on the soils concerned.

The Soil Decree of 27 October 2006 (Article 44) provides for an exploratory and descriptive soil investigation to be carried out under the direction of a soil remediation expert, in accordance with the standard procedure laid down by the Flemish Government on a proposal from the OVAM. A report of the exploratory and descriptive soil investigation is drawn up and submitted to the OVAM by the soil remediation expert in accordance with the aforementioned standard procedure. In Article 7 of the VLAREBO Decree of 14 December 2007, the Flemish Government delegated the adoption of the standard procedure for exploratory and descriptive soil research to the Flemish Environment Minister. The Ministerial Decree of the Flemish Environment Minister, which is notified with this notification message, establishes the aforementioned procedure.

The standard procedure for exploratory and descriptive soil research specifies the procedure for conducting an exploratory and descriptive soil research on the basis of binding, guiding and advisory elements on the implementation (including preliminary study, source determination, determination of research strategy and implementation, risk assessment, and assessment of the need for soil remediation) and the reporting and data transfer.

9. The notified Ministerial Decree with the established standard procedure aims to ensure the qualitative performance of an exploratory and descriptive soil survey led by accredited soil remediation experts. The standard procedure for exploratory and descriptive soil investigation is a guide for the recognised soil remediation experts to carry out the exploratory and descriptive soil investigation in a systematic and careful manner: identification of contaminated land for which further investigation is necessary.

examination of the identified soil contamination (type, nature, quantity, concentration, origin, and extent of the pollutants or organisms), risk analysis concerning the identified soil contamination (the potential for its spread and the risk of exposure to humans, plants, and animals, and to groundwater and surface water), assessment of the necessity for soil remediation, and the reporting of the findings and assessments in an exploratory and descriptive soil investigation report.
