ORDER

RE: ORDER NO. 390 OF 21 JULY 2003 OF THE MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF LITHUANIA CONCERNING AMENDMENT OF “APPROVAL OF TECHNICAL CONSTRUCTION REGULATION STR 2.07.01:2003: WATER SUPPLY AND WASTEWATER DISPOSAL PLANT. ENGINEERING SYSTEMS OF THE BUILDING. OUTDOOR ENGINEERING NETWORKS”.

1. I hereby amend existing Order No. 390 of 21 July 2003 of the Minister for the Environment of the Republic of Lithuania concerning amendment of “Approval of Technical Construction Regulation STR 2.07.01:2003: Water Supply and Wastewater Disposal Plant. Engineering Systems of the Building. Outdoor Engineering Networks”.

1.1. I hereby amend the preamble to read as follows:

“In accordance with Article 8(1)(1) and (5) of the Republic of Lithuania Law on Construction and in implementation of paragraph 1.30 of Resolution No. 280 of 26 February 2002 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania on the implementation of the Republic of Lithuania Law on Construction.”

1.2. The Order specified above amends Technical Construction Regulation STR 2.07.01:2003 “Water supply and wastewater disposal plant. Engineering Systems of the Building. Outdoor Engineering Networks”.

1.2.1. The following supplements are hereby added to paragraphs 32¹ and 32²:

„32¹. Products referred to in Article 7(2) of the Drinking Water Act that are placed on the market for use in the installation, reconstruction, repair of water engineering systems in construction works must be certified in accordance with the procedure laid down in Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370 of 23 January 2024 supplementing Directive (EU) 2020/2184 of the European Parliament and of the Council by laying down the procedures for assessing the conformity of products that come into contact with water intended for human consumption and the rules on the designation of conformity assessment bodies carrying out those procedures, and must have an EU declaration of conformity in the form specified in the Annex to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, with the exceptions provided for in point 32² of the Regulation.

32². The requirements of Paragraph 32¹ of the Regulation shall not apply until 30 December 2032 to:

32².1. products for which the declaration of conformity referred to in Paragraph 32³ of the Regulation has been issued before 30 December 2026;

32².2. for products for which a declaration in the form specified in the Annex to Regulation (EU) 2019/515 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 March 2019 on the mutual recognition of goods lawfully marketed in another Member State and repealing Regulation (EC) No 764/2008 has been issued before 30 December 2026;

32².3. products which, in accordance with the principle of mutual recognition as defined in point 3.2 of Resolution No. 1252 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 9 October 2003 on the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2019/515 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 March 2019 on the concept of the principle of mutual recognition of goods lawfully marketed in another Member State and repealing Regulation (EC) No. 764/2008, are introduced from a country where, on the basis of Article 11(3) of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, they are allowed to be placed on the market without certification in accordance with the procedure laid down in Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370“.

1.2.2. I hereby supplement paragraph 32³ to read as follows:

„32³. Manufacturers or their authorised representatives of products referred to in Article 7(2) of the Drinking Water Act, intended for use in the installation, reconstruction or repair of water supply systems in buildings, when placing these products on the market of the Republic of Lithuania, may draw up a declaration of conformity in the form set out in Annex 24 to the Regulation, confirming that the product complies with the requirements laid down in Article 7(1) of the Drinking Water Act.”

1.2.3. I hereby supplement paragraph 32⁴ to read as follows:

„32⁴. The Construction Sector Development Agency, a public body, designates conformity assessment bodies authorised to carry out the third-party tasks referred to in Article 2 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, relating to the conformity assessment of products intended for use in the installation, reconstruction or repair of water supply systems in buildings, designates such bodies, decides on the amendment, temporary suspension and withdrawal of such designation, and the lifting of the temporary suspension of designation in accordance with Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, the Law on Conformity Assessment of the Republic of Lithuania, and Resolution No. 674 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 4 July 2006 ‘On the designation of a conformity assessment body to carry out product conformity assessment procedures and the approval of the procedure for notification to the European Commission, the European Union and other states (notification), and the designation of institutions authorised by the Government’.”

1.2.4. Points 319¹ and 319² are added:

„319¹. Products referred to in § 7(2) of the Drinking Water Act that are placed on the market and are intended for use in the construction, reconstruction or repair of outdoor water supply networks must be certified in accordance with the procedure laid down in Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370 and have an EU declaration of conformity in the form set out in the Annex to Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, with the exceptions provided for in Point 319² of the Regulation.

319². The requirements of Paragraph 319¹ of the Regulation shall not apply before 30 December 2032 to:

319².1. products for which the declaration of conformity referred to in Item 319³ of the Regulation has been issued until 30 December 2026;

319².2. products for which a declaration in the form referred to in the Annex to Regulation (EU) 2019/515 has been issued by 30 December 2026;

319².3. products which, in accordance with the principle of mutual recognition as defined in point 3.2 of Resolution No. 1252 of the Government of the Republic of Lithuania of 9 October 2003 on the implementation of Regulation (EU) 2019/515 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 19 March 2019 on the concept of the principle of mutual recognition of goods lawfully marketed in another Member State and repealing Regulation (EC) No. 764/2008, are introduced from a country where, on the basis of Article 11(3) of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, they are allowed to be placed on the market without certification in accordance with the procedure laid down in Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370“.

1.2.5. I do hereby supplement with paragraph 319³ to read as follows:

„319³. Manufacturers of products referred to in Article 7(2) of the Law on Drinking Water intended for use in the construction, reconstruction or repair of outdoor water supply networks or their authorised representatives may, when placing such products on the market of the Republic of Lithuania, draw up a declaration of conformity in the form specified in Annex 24 to the Regulation, certifying that the product complies with the requirements laid down in Article 7(1) of the Law on Drinking Water.”

1.2.6. I hereby supplement paragraph 319⁴ to read as follows:

„319⁴. The Construction Sector Development Agency, a public body, designates conformity assessment bodies authorised to carry out the third-party tasks specified in Article 2 of Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, relating to the conformity assessment of products intended for use in the construction, reconstruction or repair of outdoor water supply networks, designates such bodies, decides on the amendment, temporary suspension and withdrawal of such designation, and the lifting of the temporary suspension of designation in accordance with Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/370, the Conformity Assessment Act, and Government Resolution No. 674 of 4 July 2006 ‘On the designation of a conformity assessment body to carry out conformity assessment procedures for products and the approval of the procedure for notification to the European Commission, the European Union and other states (notification), and the designation of authorities authorised by the Government’.”

1.2.7. I hereby supplement the List with Annex 24 (attached).

2. I hereby determine that subparagraphs 1.2.1, 1.2.3, 1.2.4 and 1.2.6 of this Order shall enter into force on 31 December 2026.
