Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 on the provision of food information to consumers: Articles 40, 43, 44 and 45

The reference “a/i” must be included where the product contains ingredients or processing aids that cause allergies or intolerances, as listed in Annex II to Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011.

8. The purpose of the Royal Decree is to regulate labelling that ensures the universal accessibility of those consumer goods and products that are of particular relevance to protection of the safety, integrity and quality of life of persons with disabilities, especially persons with visual disabilities, as vulnerable consumers. In addition, the regulations cover personalised assistance in shops for people with visual impairments, as well as any ad hoc help required by those who, due to their disability, request it during the shopping process.

This labelling shall apply to consumer goods and products of particular relevance to the protection of the safety, well-being and quality of life of people with disabilities, as listed in the Annex to this standard, and that are marketed in Spain. The labels shall be printed in retail establishments with a sales and display area of 1,000 m² or more.

The products to be covered are defined in the Annex.

9. Law 4/2022 of 25 February 2022 on the protection of consumers and users against situations of social and economic vulnerability, includes in its first additional provision a mandate to the Government to develop labelling in Braille:

First additional provision. Inclusive labelling.

Within one year of the entry into force of this Law, the Government shall develop regulatory labelling in Braille, as well as in other formats that guarantee the universal accessibility of consumer goods and products of particular relevance to the protection of safety, integrity and quality of life, especially for blind and visually impaired persons as vulnerable consumers.

This Royal Decree aims to comply with the mandate of the Law by regulating labelling in Braille for persons with visual disabilities, as well as for vulnerable consumers.

9a. It is the only measure available to achieve the objective pursued.

9b. The need to comply with the legal mandate and provide a solution for people with visual impairments.

9c. Every effort has been made to implement the measure with the least possible burden.
