Regulations amending the Swedish Transport Agency's Regulations (TSFS 2009:31) on bicycles, horse-drawn vehicles and kicksleds;

The Swedish Transport Agency hereby prescribes¹, pursuant to Chapter 8, Section 16 of the Vehicles Ordinance (2009:211), that Chapter 1, Section 2 of the Agency's Regulations (TSFS 2009:31) on bicycles, horse-drawn vehicles and kicksleds shall read as follows.

Chapter 1

Section 2 For the purposes of these Regulations, the following definitions shall apply:

|-----------------------|---|
| <i>kicksled</i> | a vehicle fitted with runners and intended to be propelled by a person on foot; |
| <i>tandem bicycle</i> | a bicycle designed to be operated by two or more persons; |
| <i>cargo bicycle</i> | a bicycle designed primarily for transporting loads. |

In other respects, terms used in these Regulations have the same meaning as the terms used in the Road Traffic Definitions Act (2001:559), the Road Traffic Definitions Ordinance (2001:651), the Vehicle Act (2002:574), and the Vehicle Ordinance (2009:211).

These Regulations shall enter into force on DATE.
