CHAPTER I
GENERAL INFORMATION

SECTION 1

Purpose

Art. 1 This technical regulation sets out the requirements and conditions applicable to the certification of persons entitled to participate as trainers in vocational training programmes organised for occupations and activities regulated by the State Inspectorate for the Control of Boilers, Pressure Vessels and Lifting Equipment, with a view to ensuring the safe operation of installations/equipment regulated under Law No 64/2008 on the safe operation of pressure installations, lifting installations and fuel-consuming appliances, republished in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 399 of 8 June 2015, as subsequently amended and supplemented, in accordance with the provisions of the applicable technical regulations.

SECTION 2

Scope

Art. 2 The provisions of this technical regulation shall apply to persons applying for certification as trainers for the following types of vocational training programmes:

- a) specialisation, further training, qualification and training programmes for personnel involved in the operation, welding and non-destructive testing of installations and equipment, with a view to certification, in accordance with the training modules provided for in Annex 1;
- b) training programmes for personnel responsible for the technical supervision of installations, with a view to certification/renewal of certification, in accordance with the training module set out in Annex 1;
- c) training programmes for specialist technical personnel, with a view to certification/renewal of certification, in accordance with the training modules provided for in Annex 1;

Art. 3 (1) Vocational training providers accredited by ISCIR and authorised in accordance with the legal provisions in force may deliver the programmes provided for in Article 2(a) using Type C-certified trainers, in accordance with the modules provided for in Annex 1, or using specialist trainers.

(2) Vocational training providers accredited by ISCIR may deliver the programmes referred to in Article 2(b) using Type B-certified trainers or specialist trainers.

(3) Vocational training providers accredited by ISCIR may deliver the programmes provided for in Article 2(c) using Type A-certified trainers, in accordance with the modules provided for in Annex 1, or using specialist trainers.

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of (1), where no occupational standard exists, vocational training programmes shall be delivered by vocational training providers accredited by ISCIR.

SECTION 3

Art. 4 This technical regulation refers to the following normative documents:

a) Law No 64/2008 on the safe operation of pressure installations, lifting installations and fuel-consuming appliances, republished in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 399 of 8 June 2015, as subsequently amended and supplemented;

d) Order No 165/2011 of the Chief State Inspector of the State Inspectorate for the Control of Boilers, Pressure Vessels and Lifting Equipment approving the Methodology for the certification of specialist technical personnel in the field of ISCIR, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 572 of 11 August 2011, as subsequently amended and supplemented;

e) Order No 8/2009 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR concerning the certification of persons entitled to participate as trainers in vocational training programmes organised for occupations regulated by the State Inspectorate for the Control of Boilers, Pressure Vessels and Lifting Equipment, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 57 of 29 January 2009, as subsequently amended and supplemented;

f) Order No 266/2007 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR approving the Regulations on the specific professional training for trainers of operators responsible for the technical supervision of installations – RSVTI, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 498 of 25 July 2007;

g) Order No 526/2007 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR concerning the qualification of trainers of personnel responsible for the supervision and technical inspection of installations – RSVTI, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 739 of 31 October 2007;

h) Order No 465 of 28 September 2009 of the Chief State Inspector of the State Inspectorate for the Control of Boilers, Pressure Vessels and Lifting equipment regarding approval of the Methodology for the certification of specialist technical personnel in the field of ISCIR, Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, No 750 of 4 November 2009.

SECTION 4

Terms, definitions and abbreviations

Art. 5 For the purposes of this technical regulation, the terms, definitions and abbreviations used shall have the following meanings:

a) **certification** – the activity of assessing the professional competence of a natural person to carry out a specific activity governed by the provisions of the applicable technical regulations;

b) **certificate** – the document issued by ISCIR on the basis of an assessment;

c) **qualification** – vocational training leading to the acquisition of a set of professional skills enabling a person to carry out activities specific to one or more occupations;

d) **requirement** – any rule, obligation, prohibition, condition or limitation imposed on authorised natural or legal persons or recipients of services, which is laid down in the regulatory or administrative acts of the competent authorities, or resulting from case law, administrative practices, rules of professional bodies or collective rules of professional associations or other professional organisations, adopted in the exercise of their self-regulatory powers; clauses of collective agreements negotiated with social partners are not, of themselves, considered to constitute requirements;

e) **examination** – a process that takes place at the end of a vocational training programme to assess technical knowledge and skills with a view to certification;

f) **Type A, B or C certified trainer** – a natural person certified by ISCIR for one or more fields in accordance with the provisions of this technical regulation;

g) **expert trainer** – a natural person designated by order of the Chief State Inspector of the ISCIR;

h) **specialist trainer** – a natural person certified by the ISCIR in accordance with the legal provisions and designated by order of the Chief State Inspector of the ISCIR;

i) **vocational training provider** – a service provider that is a legal entity governed by public or private law, whose articles of association specify vocational training activities;

- j) **training** – professional training leading to the development or enhancement of professional knowledge, skills or competences enabling a person to carry out specific activities;
- k) **ISCIR** – State Inspectorate for the Control of Boilers, Pressure Vessels and Lifting equipment;
- l) **RSVTI operator** – an operator responsible for the technical supervision of installations/equipment, authorised in accordance with the provisions of the applicable technical regulation;
- m) **vocational training programme** – all of the theoretical and/or practical training activities undertaken in order to achieve the objectives of skills training for a specific field;
- n) **service personnel** – a natural person certified by ISCIR, in accordance with the provisions of this applicable technical specification, to service installations/equipment within their field of activity in accordance with the provisions of the applicable technical specifications;
- o) **specialised technical staff (PTS)** – the authorised natural person certified in accordance with the provisions of the applicable technical regulation to carry out the specific activities provided for in the applicable technical regulations;
- p) **Upskilling/specialisation/specialisation** – vocational training leading to the development or honing of the professional knowledge, skills or competences of a person already holding a qualification, i.e. the development of skills within the same qualification, the acquisition of new skills in the same or a new occupational area, or the acquisition of fundamental/key skills or new technical skills;
- q) **technical regulation** – a technical norm drawn up by ISCIR and approved by order of the Minister for Economic Affairs, Digitalisation, Entrepreneurship and Tourism, published in the Official Gazette of Romania, Part I, containing, for clearly defined areas, conditions and technical requirements relating to installations/equipment and activities specific to the field of activity that are carried out in connection with them, in view of placing on the market, putting into service and using those installations/equipment safely in operation;
- r) **RADTA-IP** – specialist technical staff responsible for approving technical documentation relating to pressure equipment automation systems;
- s) **RADTE-IP** – specialist technical staff responsible for approving the technical documentation for technical investigations/examinations and supervising in-service technical verification works to estimate the remaining lifespan of pressure equipment;
- t) **RADTE-IR** – specialist technical staff responsible for approving the technical documentation for technical investigations/examinations and supervising in-service technical verification works to estimate the remaining lifespan of lifting equipment;

- u) **RADTI-IP** – specialist technical staff responsible for approving the preliminary technical documentation for assembling pressure equipment, certified according to the provisions of the applicable technical regulation;
- v) **RADTP-IP** – specialist technical staff responsible for approving the preliminary technical documentation for assembling/repairing pressure equipment;
- w) **RADTP-IR** – specialist technical staff responsible for approving the preliminary technical documentation for assembling/repairing lifting equipment;
- x) **RSL-IP** – specialist technical staff responsible for supervising work on pressure equipment;
- y) **RSL-IR** – specialist technical staff responsible for supervising work on lifting equipment;
- z) **RTED** – specialist technical staff for destructive testing;
- aa) **RTEND** – specialist technical staff for non-destructive testing;
- bb) **RTS** – specialist technical staff technically responsible for welding on pressure installations and lifting equipment;
- cc) **RVT** – specialist technical staff responsible for technical verification;
- dd) **RVTA** – specialist technical staff responsible for the technical verification of lifts.

CHAPTER II

CERTIFICATION OF TRAINERS

SECTION 1

General provisions

Art. 6 Persons wishing to participate as a trainer in one of the vocational training programmes defined in Article 2 must follow a training programme organised by ISCIR.

Art. 7 Persons wishing to participate as a trainer in one of the vocational training programmes defined in Article 2 must meet all of the following general conditions:

- a) have graduated a technical higher education programme and hold a bachelor's degree or diploma in the following fields: mechanical or electromechanical engineering, transport, industrial machinery, robotics, electrical engineering, electronics, energy, automation, construction, metallurgy, engineering physics, industrial chemistry, plant engineering, oil and gas, or other related technical fields accepted by ISCIR;
- b) hold a valid medical certificate issued by an occupational health doctor confirming that they are fit to work as a trainer;

- c) hold a ‘trainer’ certificate issued by a vocational training provider accredited in accordance with the law;
- d) provide evidence that they meet the minimum required length of service in the relevant field, in accordance with this technical regulation.

SECTION 2

Specific provisions

Art. 8 (1) Persons wishing to participate in the programmes referred to in Article 2(a) must comply with the requirements laid down in Article 7 and be able to prove that they have at least two years’ experience, from the date of obtaining the diploma, in the fields referred to in Article 7(a).

(2) Specialist inspectors within ISCIR with at least two years’ experience shall be exempt from the provisions of (1).

Art. 9 (1) Persons wishing to participate in the programmes referred to in Article 2(b) must comply with the requirements laid down in Article 7 and be able to prove that they have at least three years’ experience, from the date of obtaining the diploma, in the fields referred to in Article 7(a).

(2) Specialist inspectors within ISCIR with at least three years’ experience shall be exempt from the provisions of (1).

Art. 10 (1) Persons wishing to participate in the programmes referred to in Article 2(c) must comply with the requirements laid down in Article 7 and be able to prove that they have at least eight years’ experience, from the date of obtaining the diploma, in the fields referred to in Article 7(a).

(2) Specialist inspectors within ISCIR with at least eight years’ experience shall be exempt from the provisions of (1).

Art. 11 (1) To register for one of the training modules provided for in Annex 1, the applicant shall submit the following documents to ISCIR:

- a) an application form specifying the type of certificate required; the application must include consent for personal data to be collected, processed and stored by ISCIR in accordance with the relevant legislation;
- b) a copy of the technical qualification certificate or licence, or of the document certifying the equivalence of military and civilian roles, where applicable;

- c) their curriculum vitae;
 - d) a copy of the document proving the relevant professional experience referred to in Articles 8–10, as applicable;
 - e) a copy of their identity document;
 - f) the documents referred to in Article 7(b) and (c).
- (2) if the applicant wishes to take the examination at the end of the training module, this must be mentioned in the application referred to in (1)(a).

Art. 12 (1) Specialist inspectors within ISCIR who meet the seniority requirements set for each category of trainer may, in accordance with the provisions of Articles 8–10, register for the certification examination without attending the training module.

(2) In order to be admitted to the certification examination, the person referred to in (1) shall submit the documents referred to in Article 7(c) and Article 11(1)(a) and, if their time at ISCIR is less than that referred to in Articles 8 to 10, the document referred to in Article 11(1)(d).

SECTION 3

Organisation of training modules

Art. 13 (1) The training modules shall be organised by ISCIR.

(2) The schedule for participants enrolled in the training module shall be published on the ISCIR website.

Art. 14 The training modules shall be delivered in accordance with the detailed syllabus set out in Annex 2.

Art. 15 (1) Persons applying for a Type A, B or C trainer's certificate shall be trained by specialist trainers appointed by order of the ISCIR Chief State Inspector.

(2) Specialist inspectors with at least 10 years' experience in their field, of which at least 5 years must have been spent at ISCIR, may be appointed as trainers, in accordance with the methodology approved by order of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR.

Art. 16 (1) At the end of the training module, ISCIR shall issue participants with the certificate of participation, as per the template provided for in Annex 3.

(2) The certificate referred to in (1) shall be valid for 24 months from the date of issue.

SECTION 4

Examination and issue of the certificate

Art. 17 Those who complete the training module may sit the certification exam immediately afterwards or at a later date.

Art. 18 (1) The certification examination shall be taken based on the certificate of participation in the training module, for the type of certification referred to in Annex 1, and specified in the examination request referred to in Article 11(1)(a).

(2) In the case of an examination at a later date, the applicant shall submit the following documents to ISCIR:

- a) an application form specifying the type of certificate required; the application must include consent for personal data to be collected, processed and stored by ISCIR in accordance with the relevant legislation;
- b) a copy of their identity document;
- c) the occupational health aptitude sheet provided for in Article 7(b), within its validity period;
- d) the certificate of participation in the training module referred to in Article 16, within its validity period.

Art. 19 Applicants wishing to be certified as Type B trainers may register for the examination provided for in Article 17, provided that they submit a valid certificate of attendance for Module M.4 or valid certificates of attendance for Modules M.1 and M.2.

Art. 20 (1) The examination board shall be appointed by order of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR.

(2) The examination board shall consist of three members and a secretary.

(3) Members of the examination board shall be specialist trainers, one of whom shall be appointed chairman of the board.

Art. 21 (1) The examination shall consist of two tests: a written paper and an interview.

(2) The written paper shall consist of a questionnaire containing at least 30 questions.

(3) The interview shall consist in assessing the candidate's knowledge of the relevant technical specifications and applicable legislation.

(4) To pass the exam, candidates must obtain a minimum mark of 7 (seven) in each of the two papers.

Art. 22 (1) Upon passing the examination, ISCIR shall issue a certificate as per the template provided for in Annex 4, provided that proof of payment of the relevant fees is submitted.

(2) The certificate is valid for 4 (four) years.

CHAPTER III

RENEWAL OF THE VALIDITY OF CERTIFICATES

Art. 23 Persons wishing to renew the validity of their trainer certificate must, within a maximum of 12 months prior to the certificate's expiry date, complete a training programme in accordance with the procedure described in SECTION 3 of CHAPTER II of these technical regulations, and submit the following to ISCIR:

- a) the registration application specifying the training module for which renewal of validity is requested; the application must include agreement that the personal data be collected, processed and kept by ISCIR in accordance with the legal provisions;
- b) a copy of their identity document;
- c) a copy of the trainer certificate for which renewal of validity is requested;
- d) proof of payment of the training course fee.

Art. 24 (1) At least 30 days before the expiry date of the certificates, applicants must submit the following documents to the ISCIR regional office within whose jurisdiction they reside or carry out their activities:

- a) the application for renewal of the validity of the certificate;
- b) the certificate issued by ISCIR, in original;
- c) a copy of their identity document;
- d) the certificate of participation in the course, as per the template provided for in Annex 3;
- e) proof of payment of the fee for renewal of validity of the certificate.

(2) ISCIR shall examine the documentation submitted and, if it complies with the provisions of (1), grant renewal for a further four years, to run from the expiry date.

(3) In the case of persons failing to submit the documents required for renewal of their certificates in accordance with the requirements set out in Article 24(1), ISCIR shall reject the certificate renewal application; the documentation submitted shall be archived, and the applicant will have to restart the certification process.

CHAPTER IV
OBLIGATIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Art. 25 The obligations and responsibilities of persons certified as trainers by ISCIR are as follows:

- a) to use the approved venue and adhere to the stated timetable and training topic;
- b) to conduct their training activity only with those persons registered and communicated to ISCIR on the definitive list submitted by the vocational training provider;
- c) not to conduct multiple vocational training programmes at the same time.

CHAPTER V
ADMINISTRATIVE MEASURES

Art. 26 (1) In the event of non-compliance with the obligations and responsibilities laid down in this technical regulation by the ISCIR certified trainer, the following administrative measures may be applied, depending on their nature:

- a) warning for infringement of Article 25(a);
- b) suspension of the trainer's certificate for a period of up to 3 (three) months for infringement of the provisions of Article 25(b);
- c) suspension of the trainer's certificate for a period of 3 (three) to 6 (six) months for infringement of the provisions of Article 25(c).

(2) The application within 3 (three) months of two administrative measures referred to in (1)(a) shall give rise to application of the administrative measure referred to in (1)(b).

(3) The application within 1 (one) year of two administrative measures referred to in (1)(b) or (c) shall give rise to withdrawal of the trainer certificate.

(4) The administrative measures referred to in (1)(b) and (c) shall be applied in compliance with the legal provisions in force and the principle of proportionality.

(5) The administrative measures shall be ordered by ISCIR, by reasoned decision, on the basis of the technical verification report written up by the specialist ISCIR inspector when the verification is performed. A template for this report is provided in Annex 5.

(6) Trainers certified by ISCIR may appeal the decision ordering application of the administrative measure before the competent court according to the procedure provided for in the law on administrative litigation.

CHAPTER VI

TARIFFS

Art. 27 (1) The applicable tariffs for activities undertaken by ISCIR in accordance with the provisions of this technical regulation shall be those set out in the schedule of tariffs approved in accordance with the legislation in force.

(2) ISCIR shall undertake the activities provided for in this technical regulation only for the benefit of natural and legal persons in respect of whom debt recovery procedures provided for under the legislation in force have not been initiated.

CHAPTER VII

TRANSITIONAL provisions

Art. 28 (1) Individuals holding certificates issued under the provisions of Order No 8/2009 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR may continue to work as specific Type C trainers until their certificates expire.

(2) Persons holding certificates issued under the provisions of Order No 266/2007 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR and Order No 526/2007 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR may continue their activity as Type B trainers for 24 months from the date of entry into force of this technical regulation, during which time they may apply for the Type B trainer certificate.

(3) Persons holding certificates issued under the provisions of Order No 13/2009 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR on the appointment of expert trainers who are members of the certification committee for persons participating in vocational training programmes in the field regulated by ISCIR, as subsequently amended and supplemented, may continue to work as a Type A, B or C trainer for 24 months from the date of entry into force of this technical regulation, during which time they may apply for the Type A.1–A.3, B and/or C.1–C.7 trainer certificate.

(4) Persons holding certificates issued under the provisions of Order No 165/2011 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR may continue their activity as Type A.1, A.2 or A.3 trainers for 24 months from the date of entry into force of this technical regulation, during which time they may apply for the Type A.1, A.2 or A.3 trainer certificate.

(5) Persons holding certificates issued pursuant the provisions of Order No 465/2009 of the Chief State Inspector of ISCIR approving the Methodology for the Certification of Specialist Technical Personnel in the Field of ISCIR, as amended, may continue to work as Type A.1, A.2 or A.3 trainers, depending on the type of certificate held, for 12 months from the date of entry into force of

this technical regulation, during which time they may apply for the Type A.1, A.2 or A.3 trainer certificate, as applicable.

Art. 29 (1) In order to issue the specific certificate, the persons provided for in Article 28(2) to (5) must submit the following documents to ISCIR:

a) an application specifying the type of certificate requested; the application must include consent for personal data to be collected, processed and stored by ISCIR in accordance with the relevant legislation;

b) a copy of the certificate held;

c) a copy of their ID.

(2) ISCIR shall review the submitted documentation and issue the certificate.

(3) The certificate shall be issued once the related fees have been paid in accordance with the legal provisions in force.

CHAPTER VIII

FINAL PROVISIONS

Art. 30 All documents submitted to ISCIR must be written in Romanian or translated into Romanian by an authorised translator.

Art. 31 Certification application documents may also be submitted to ISCIR in electronic form via the electronic single point of contact (SPoC), provided for in Article 6 of Government Emergency Order No 49/2009 on the freedom of establishment of service providers and the freedom to provide services in Romania, as amended.

Art. 32 The deadlines for resolving applications submitted to ISCIR shall be those established according to the legal provisions in force.

Art. 33 (1) Duplicate certificates shall be issued by ISCIR in the following cases and under the following conditions:

a) in the event of loss, subject to the submission by the document holder of a self-declaration to ISCIR;

b) in the event of theft, subject to the submission by the document holder of a copy of the Police complaint registration document to ISCIR;

c) in the event of damage, subject to the submission by the document holder of a copy of the damaged document or, in the event of total destruction, a statement from the applicant, to ISCIR.

(2) In order to obtain a duplicate, the holder must submit to ISCIR, in addition to the documents referred to in (1), an application for its issue, accompanied by a copy of their identity document.

(3) ISCIR shall examine the documents referred to in (1) and (2) and decide whether or not to issue the duplicate of the requested document within 30 days of submission of the documents.

Art. 34 (1) In order to request derogations from the provisions of this technical regulation, the applicant shall submit the following to ISCIR:

- a) an application for derogation from the provisions of the technical regulation;
- b) documentary evidence, including a description of the situation;
- c) other documents in support of the application, as appropriate.

(2) On the basis of the documentation submitted, ISCIR shall accept or reject the application in writing, giving reasons.

Art. 35 Annexes 1 to 5 form an integral part of this technical regulation.
