Decree No of
relating to the conditions for application of Article L. 1115-5 of the Transport Code

NOR: [TRAT2531914D]

Target audience: the Transport Regulatory Authority; data holders whose data enables the provision of multimodal travel information services; and users of such data.

Subject: *The Decree sets out the implementing provisions for Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code, which entrusts the Transport Regulatory Authority with the task of monitoring compliance with their obligations by the holders and users of data enabling the provision of travel information services. It specifies that the declaration of conformity, the accuracy of which the Transport Regulatory Authority must check, is that referred to in Article 9 of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926 of 31 May 2017. In this context, it extends the categories of data that may be the subject of a request for access to include ‘observed’ data within the meaning of Article 2 of the aforementioned Delegated Regulation. The Decree introduces the possibility for third parties, in particular accredited consumer organisations, to submit reports to the Authority so that it may, on its own initiative, carry out checks on declarations of conformity, in accordance with the second paragraph of Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code. It specifies that the Order setting out the format and content of the declaration of conformity will be issued following the Authority’s advice, and that such declarations must be submitted to the Minister responsible for Transport by 1 January of each year at the latest.*

Entry into force: *the Decree shall enter into force on the day after its publication.*

Application: *this Decree is adopted for the application of Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code as amended by Article 29 of Law No 2025-391 of 30 April 2025 laying down various provisions for adapting European Union law in the economic, financial, environmental, energy, transport, health and movement of persons fields.*

Having regard to Directive 2023/2661/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 22 November 2023 amending the Directive 2010/40/EU on the framework for the deployment of intelligent transport systems in the field of road transport and for interfaces with other modes of transport;

Having regard to Directive 2015/1535/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 9 September 2015 laying down a procedure for the provision of information in the field of technical regulations and of rules on Information Society services;

European Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926 of 31 May 2017 supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the provision of EU-wide multimodal travel information services;

Having regard to the Transport Code, in particular Articles L.1115-1, L.1115-3, L.1115-5, L.1115-6, L.1115-7 thereof;

Having regard to the Road Infrastructure Law, in particular Article L.141-13;

Having regard to the Consumer Code, in particular Article L.811-1 thereof;

Having regard to Law No. 2025-391 of 30 April 2025 containing various provisions for alignment with European Union law in the fields of the economy, finance, the environment, energy, transport, health and the movement of persons, and in particular Article 29 thereof;

Having regard to Decree No. 2020-1753 of 28 December 2020 on certain conditions for the provision of digital data intended to facilitate travel;

Having regard to the opinion of the Transport Regulatory Authority of 13 November 2025;

Having regard to the opinion of the National Council for the Assessment of Standards dated xxx;

Having regard to Notification No xxx addressed to the European Commission on xxx;

Having heard the Council of State (public works section),

Hereby decrees:

[Article 1]

Article R. 1115-5 of the Transport Code is amended as follows:

1° In the first paragraph, the words ‘in the first paragraph of Article L.1263-4’ are replaced by the words: ‘in 1° of Article L.1115-1 of this Code’ and after the words: ‘the declaration of conformity referred to in Article L.1115-5’ the words ‘of this Code’ are inserted.

2° A third paragraph shall be inserted, worded as follows: ‘The declaration of conformity referred to in the first subparagraph of this Article shall correspond to that referred to in Article 9(2)(c) of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926 of 31 May 2017 supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council with regard to the provision of multimodal travel information services throughout the Union. The

declaration shall make it possible to verify compliance with the obligations referred to in Articles 3 to 8 of the above-mentioned Delegated Regulation. ’

[Article 2]

The first subparagraph of Article R.1115-7 of the Transport Code is amended as follows:

1° The words ‘in the first subparagraph of Article L.1263-4’ are replaced by the words ‘in point 1 of Article L.1115-1 of this Code’.

2° After the words ‘any historical, static data’, the word ‘observed’ shall be inserted.

3° After the word ‘dynamic’, the words ‘within the meaning of Article 2 of the aforementioned Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926’ are inserted.

[Article 3]

Article R.1115-7-1 is inserted after Article R.1115-7 as follows:

‘Article R.1115-7-1. – Within the framework of its tasks set out in the first subparagraph of Article L.1115-5 of this Code, the Transport Regulatory Authority may receive reports from third parties, in particular from consumer associations approved under Article L.811 of the Consumer Code.

[Article 4]

Article R.1115-8 is amended as follows:

1° In I, the following words are inserted after the words ‘responsible for transport’: ‘adopted following consultation with the Transport Regulatory Authority’

2° In II:

- a) The words: ‘in respect of the years 2021 and 2022’ are deleted;
- b) The words: ‘no later than 1 March of each of those years, respectively. As from 2023, they shall be transmitted’ shall be deleted;
- c) After the word ‘January’, the following words are inserted: ‘of each year’.

[Article 5]

The Minister for Spatial Planning and Decentralisation, the Minister responsible for Transport shall be responsible, within the scope of their respective competences, for the implementation of this Decree, which shall be published in the *Official Journal* of the French Republic.
