5. Draft decree implementing Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code

6. Information society services aimed at making available data and information services on intermodal transport as defined in Article 2 of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926, of 31 May 2017.

8. The draft decree is issued pursuant to the aforementioned Article L.1115-5. It amends Articles R.1115-5 to R.1115-8 of the Transport Code by providing several clarifications concerning the powers of the Transport Regulatory Authority [l'Autorité de régulation des transports] (ART) and its audit tools, in particular the declaration of conformity.

The draft decree confirms that the declaration of conformity mentioned in Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code corresponds to that mentioned in Article 9, Section 2, of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926, of 31 May 2017.

It specifies that the obligation to provide data via the intermodal transport national access point [point d'accès national] (PAN) covers static, historical and observed data relating to travel and traffic in accordance with Article 4, Section 1, of the amended delegated regulation and dynamic data in accordance with its Article 5, Section 1.

It opens up the possibility for the Transport Regulatory Authority (ART) to receive reports from third parties, including approved consumer associations, in order to carry out verifications on the accuracy of declarations of conformity.

9. Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code aims to specify the conditions for the application of Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) 2017/1926, of 31 May 2017, supplementing Directive 2010/40/EU of the Parliament and of the Council, of 7 July 2010, as regards the provision, throughout the EU, of information services on intermodal transport. It was amended by Delegated Regulation (EU) 2024/490, of 29 November 2023. This delegated regulation defines the procedures for making available data relating to intermodal transport throughout the EU. It provides that holders of intermodal transport data make available the data they have on a national access point using formats defined in the regulation, that users of this data comply with certain conditions of use, and that compliance with these obligations is monitored by the competent authorities of the Member States.

Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code, introduced by Law No. 2019-1428, of 24 December 2019, on mobility planning, assigned to the Transport Regulatory Authority the task of monitoring compliance by data holders and users with their obligations provided for in Articles L.1115-1 to L.1115-3 of the Transport Code. Law No. 2025-391, of 30 April 2025, amended Article L.1115-5 of the Transport Code, notably by requiring the publication of an annual audit report.
