5. Order of ... establishing the maximum permissible levels of metal trace elements and organic trace compounds added to the soil when fertilisers are used

6. Applies to all fertilisers placed on the market in France with the exception of fertilisers complying with the CE marking (Regulation (EU) No 2019/1009).

8. This Order establishes the values and procedures for assessing the safety of fertilisers as regards the maximum permissible levels of trace metal elements, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons and polychlorinated biphenyls.

9. This text is part of a regulatory draft stemming from Law No 2020 of 10 February 2020 on fighting waste and on the circular economy, which added a new Article L255-9-1 to the Rural and Maritime Fishing Code. This establishes that a Decree shall establish the agronomic performance and safety criteria for fertilisers and growing media according to their conditions of use, in order to ensure that their placement on the market and use do not harm public health, animal health and the environment.

This draft Regulation consists of four complementary texts:

- the Order establishing the maximum permissible levels of metal trace elements and organic trace compounds added to the soil when fertilisers are used, which is the subject of this notification;
- a Decree establishing the procedures for monitoring and labelling the agronomic performance and safety criteria for fertilisers and growing media;
- a Decree establishing the agronomic performance and safety criteria for fertilisers and growing media;
- an Order establishing the values and procedures for assessing the safety and end-of-waste status criteria for fertilisers and growing media.

The draft Regulation aims to support the development of alternatives to mineral and synthetic fertilisers. It establishes the safety criteria for fertilisers, including materials recovered from the circular economy and recycling, in order to control soil and crop contamination resulting from fertilising practices.

It does not preclude the free movement of fertilisers complying with the CE marking under Regulation (EU) No 2019/1009 laying down rules on the making available on the market of EU fertilising products.
