

Impact of the regulation

The amendments proposed by the draft Act do not have a social, including demographic impact, or impact on national security and foreign relations, or on the living and natural environment and regional development. There is no impact on the organisation of state agencies and local governments either.

The implementation of the Regulation will result in the harmonisation of the Estonian legislation on radio communication with international legislation governing radio communication. Fulfilment of the requirements laid down in the Regulation will prevent interference as well as ensure interoperability and safe use of radio equipment.

The implementation of the Regulation will promote enterprise and thus indirectly the national economy, as the introduction of new frequency bands will provide an opportunity for the development of electronic communication systems, the expansion and development of electronic communication services and the use of new technologies.

The implementation of the Regulation does not restrict the rights of persons using the existing radio frequencies, but extends them by allowing the use of radio equipment without a frequency licence.
