5. Regulation of the Minister for Interior Affairs and Administration on technical conditions for protective structures and technical conditions for their use and location

6. Technical requirements for protective structures and their location and technical requirements for their use. In particular, the draft author introduced technical requirements for the design and construction of protective structures, i.e. shelters and hideouts.

8. The Regulation lays down technical conditions to be met by collective protection facilities (shelters, hideouts) and their locations as well as usage, including:

- 1) requirements for the location of collective protection facilities,
- 2) general safety requirements for collective protection facilities,
- 3) capacity and area requirements for collective protection facilities,
- 4) requirements for entrances and passageways of collective protection facilities,
- 5) requirements for back-up exits in collective protection facilities,
- 6) requirements for rooms in collective protection facilities,
- 7) requirements for technical zone spaces in collective protection facilities,
- 8) requirements for ventilation in collective protection facilities,
- 9) requirements for electricity supply in collective protection facilities,
- 10) requirements for heating in collective protection facilities and sanitary protection facilities,
- 11) requirements for control and measurement devices in collective protection systems,
- 12) technical requirements for collective protection facilities in underground rail transport systems,
- 13) conditions for the use and maintenance of collective protection facilities,
- 14) rules for the signage of collective protection facilities.

9. The draft regulation provides detailed provisions on matters that have not been regulated to date, concerning, inter alia, the concepts and definitions relating to the categories of protective structures, as well as the general strength and construction requirements for such structures. It sets out requirements for the technical infrastructure which a collective protection facility must be equipped with in order to ensure safety for its occupants from dangers related to war activities or natural disasters. The regulation contains standards necessary at the stage of planning the location of shelters and hiding places, their design, and construction. The standards adopted for protective structures are in line with the latest technical knowledge in the field of protective construction.

The current draft is being issued on a new legal basis.

12. The draft Regulation contains technical conditions for protective structures and technical conditions for their use and location. The regulations apply to civil defence shelters and hideouts used to protect the population, primarily in the event of an armed conflict. It is necessary to urgently proceed with the regulations, in view of the repeated cases of violations of the Polish airspace and the growing threat to citizens.

Work on the first draft of the regulations setting out technical requirements for protective structures began in 2022, after the outbreak of the Russian-Ukrainian war. The draft was notified under number 2024/0412/PL. Technical requirements set out in this draft were modelled on previous national civil protection instructions

and technical requirements for military command stations.

Work on the first draft was carried out in parallel with the ongoing armed conflict in Ukraine. Data from the analysis of the evolution of hostilities, including modalities and consequences of Russia's attacks on civilian sites, were analysed taking into account an assessment of the effectiveness of the adopted requirements for protective structures. The hostilities were characterised by the use of new types of weaponry, in a manner and on a scale that had been unpredictable until then (drones and loitering munitions), which requires a different design and location of protective structures.
