

Impact of the Regulation

The amendments proposed by the draft Act do not have a social impact, demographic impact included, or impact on national security and foreign relations, on the living and natural environment or regional development. There is no impact on the organisation of state agencies and local governments either.

As a result of application of the Regulation, Estonian legislation on radio communications will be harmonised with international legislation on radio communications. Fulfilment of the requirements laid down in the Regulation will prevent interference as well as ensure interoperability and safe use of radio equipment.

The implementation of the Regulation will promote enterprise and thus indirectly the national economy, as the introduction of new frequency bands will provide an opportunity for the development of electronic communication systems and electronic communication services as well as expand them and provide an opportunity for implementing new technologies.

The Regulation is without prejudice to the rights of persons using radio frequencies, since the introduction of additional technical requirements for radio equipment used on the basis of a frequency licence and the amendment of the existing requirements will affect neither the validity of the existing frequency licences nor the requirements provided for therein.
